18	This ordinance is in response to a Virginia law that was amended in July 2023 pursuant to SB 1069.
19	Previously, the Virginia Code stated that the City of Alexandria may install signs requiring drivers
20	to yield for pedestrians crossing or attempting to cross a marked crosswalk. Va. Code Ann. § 46.2-
21	924(D) (2020). The law was expanded to allow for the installation of signs requiring drivers to stop,
22	in addition to yield signs, under these circumstances. The City Code would be amended to conform
23	to this change in state law.
