## RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATION FOR METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS REGIONAL ROADWAY SAFETY PROGRAM FOR FY 2025

**WHEREAS**, the Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP) is administered by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG); and

**WHEREAS**, RRSP is intended to fund short-term consultant services to member jurisdictions or agencies to assist with planning or preliminary engineering projects that address roadway safety issues; and

**WHEREAS**, RRSP provides up to \$100,000 in consultant assistance for planning and design projects that lead to a reduction in traffic fatalities and severe injuries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alexandria City Council adopted the Vision Zero Policy and Action Plan in 2017, which include a goal to eliminate fatal and severe injury crashes by 2028; and

**WHEREAS**, Seminary Road between North Beauregard Street and the City boundary is one of the corridors on the City's High Injury Network; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alexandria City Council desires to submit an application to the RRSP for up to \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2025 for the Seminary West Safety Improvements Study; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby supports the application for up to \$100,000 from RRSP from MWCOG for Fiscal Year 2025.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Alexandria City Council hereby grants authority to the City Manager to apply for these grant funds and enter into any necessary agreements with MWCOG to accept this grant.
