

RESOLUTION NO.3380

RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE PARKING METER AND PAY BY PHONE RATES

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by Charter Section 2.03(x) to charge for parking in spaces on its streets; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by City Code Section 5-8-92 to establish locations for parking meters and by City Code Section 5-8-84 to establish locations for pay-by-phone parking; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered by City Code Section 5-8-93(c) to set by resolution the monetary rates to be charged when parking in a metered space; and


WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered by City Code Section 5-8-84(b)(1) to set by resolution the monetary rates to be charged when parking in residential blocks with a pay by phone parking fee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to increase the hourly meter rate for meter locations where the rate was previously set at \$1.75 and increase the pay by phone parking fee for all blocks where the hourly pay by phone rate is less than \$2.75.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA


1. That for all on-street meters that were previously set at \$1.75 per hour, the rate shall be increased to \$2.75 per hour; and
2. That the hourly parking fee for residential pay by phone blocks shall be increased to \$2.75, unless the fee for a specific block was or is increased or decreased as permitted by Resolution 3080; and
3. These rates do not include any convenience fee that may be charged by the service provider for the pay by phone parking payment option; and
4. This resolution does not change the rates that were established separately for an all-day meter rate (Resolution 2903); and
5. That the City Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to affix the seal of the City to such documents as may be necessary or convenient implement this Resolution; and
6. That this Resolution shall be effective July 1, 2026.
