7 8	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
9	Section 1. That Section 0.15.12 of the Code of the City of Alexandric Virginia
10 11	Section 1. That Section 9-15-12 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended by deleting the text shown in
12	strikethrough and adding the text shown in underline as follows:

14	The following rules shall apply to all food trucks:
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16	A. Hours.
17	i. Vending may take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and <u>811</u> :00 p.m.
18	ii. A food truck may not vend for longer than foursix hours of continuous vending.
19	B. Parking locational requirements.
20	i. Food truck vendors shall not have any exclusive right to any location on public
21	property;
22	ii. Food trucks parked in a marked parking space must fit within the width and the
23 24	length of the marked parking space; iii. Occupation of any parking space shall not interfere with the lighting, trees, overhead
24 25	wires, and/or utilities;
25 26	iv. The food truck vendor shall not block any other vehicle's or pedestrian's ingress or
27	egress, cause traffic congestion, or be parked in any drive aisles or fire lanes;
28	C. Vending locational requirements.
29	i. No deliveries shall be received from another vehicle while a food truck is vending in
30	a designated on-street vending location;
31	ii. Vending shall only take place from the inside of the food truck;
32	iii. Vending shall not take place to any person while such person is standing in the
33	street unless said street has been closed to the public pursuant to a special event or
34	street closure permit issued by the city;
35	iv. Vending shall not take place to any driver or passenger in a motor vehicle while the
36 37	motor vehicle is stopped at a red light or while in a moving traffic lane; and
38	v. Food truck shall not be left unattended while vending. D. <i>Signs</i> . No sign shall be displayed except for a sign displaying a menu or signs that
39	are imprinted on the exterior body of a licensed food truck. All signs shall also comply
40	with the applicable provisions of Article IX of the zoning ordinance. The applicable
41	regulations shall include, but not be limited to, that the food truck shall not:
42	i. advertise other businesses on the food truck;
43	ii. use A-frame signs or remote signs;
44	iii. attach balloons or windblown signs to the food truck; or
45	iv. use animated or electronic signs.
46	E. Noise.

1	i. No music or other amplified announcements that are audible outside of the food truck
2	shall be allowed, except as allowed by section 13-1-26 of the city code; and
3	ii. Food truck vendors shall comply with the noise code as set forth in section 11-5-1 et
4	seq. of this code including utilizing generators that meet the requirements of the noise
5	code.
6	F. Storage. No merchandise, food, equipment, or other item related to the operation of a
7	food truck, other than a trash receptacle required by subsection H below, shall be stored
8	or kept adjacent to the food truck.
9 10	G. <i>Liquid waste</i> . No liquid wastes used in the operation of the food truck or food wonding shall be allowed to be discharged from the food truck execut into an approved
10 11	vending shall be allowed to be discharged from the food truck except into an approved sewerage system as permitted by law.
12	H. <i>Trash.</i> Portable receptacles for the disposal of waste materials or other litter shall be
13	provided by the food truck vendor for the use of customers and all food truck vendors
14	shall direct customers to place all waste and litter in the receptacles. All waste shall be
15	removed and disposed of by the food truck vendor. Public trash receptacles shall not be
16	used for compliance with this section.
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18	Section 2. That Section 9-15-12 as amended pursuant to Section 1 of this ordinance,
19	be, and the same hereby is, reordained as part of the City of Alexandria City Code.
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21	Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time
22	of its final passage.
