Staff if requesting deferral of docket item #22, which is 22-0115: Consideration of a Resolution to Support a Grant Application to the Virginia Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF) grant program. Unfortunately, the deferral is needed due to inconsistencies that just came to our attention between the docket item and the grant application submitted on 9/3/2021. The grant application submitted was for a small spot project of \$144,000 in state funding while the docket item indicates the grant request would be for up to \$4.5 to \$5.46 million. Staff will also use this time to reach out to the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation, the grant administrator, for coordination and guidance purposes. Sorry for the late notice and the request. Since the docket item for the grant is retroactive, Staff requests the grant docket be moved to 9/28/2021 to allow for edits and to resolve any issues.

Staff is in the process of reviewing several other state and federal grant opportunities and anticipates coming back to Council in October with additional grant applications.
