1. Calling the Roll.

Mayor Gaskins called the meeting to order and the City Clerk called the roll. All members of City Council were present with Vice Mayor Bagley participating virtually by Zoom webinar. Councilwoman Greene arrived following roll-call.

Approval of Electronic Participation Resolution by Members of City Council. (if needed)

City Council approved the Electronic Participation resolution. (RES. NO. 3400)

II. Moment of Silence and Pledge of Allegiance.

City Council observed a moment of silence and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. Individual Action Items (Roll-Call Vote)

3. [27-1183](#) Consideration of a request from the Independent Community Policing Review Board to conduct an additional investigation.

City Council approved the request for an additional investigation and additional information in the following areas: (1) additional review of supervisory sergeant involvement in the incident and whether additional findings should be made; (2) additional information regarding APD's training structure, including refresher training for body cameras and medical transport were last provided, as well as APD's annual training schedule and requirements; and (3) a revision in the public report that was released to include an explanation of why the auditor's disciplinary recommendations are not included and the legal authority that supports that termination. Council requested that the investigation refer to the board's formal letter and the Sheriff's letter as well. The findings and recommendations related to the officers involved will not be made a part of the auditor's public report.
