
Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) Technical Assistance Grants

Transportation Land-Use Connections (TLC) Program provides planning studies and work that promote mixed-use, walkable communities and transportation alternatives.

Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP) provides planning and preliminary engineering to address roadway safety issues to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes.

Both MWCOG technical assistance grants:

- Up to \$100,000 in short-term consultant services
- Applications are due March 8, 2024
- If awarded, work starts fall 2024
- Work to be completed by June 30, 2025




Seminary Road (RRSP)

Technical assistance to study safety improvements on Seminary Road between North Beauregard Street and the City boundary to advance Vision Zero safety initiatives.

Edsall Road (TLC)

Technical assistance support for outreach and design for multimodal corridor improvements on Edsall Road between South Pickett Street and the City line, as recommended in the Alexandria Mobility Plan.



That City Council approve resolutions to:

- 1. Support the submission of a grant application by March 8 for up to \$100,000 in technical assistance to perform planning, outreach, and conceptual corridor improvements on Edsall Road between South Pickett Street and the City line,
- Support the submission of a grant application by March 8 for up to \$100,000 in technical assistance to study safety improvements on Seminary Road between North Beauregard Street and the City line, and
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to apply for TLC and RRSP technical assistance through MWCOG and enter any agreements with MWCOG to accept and implement the grants.
