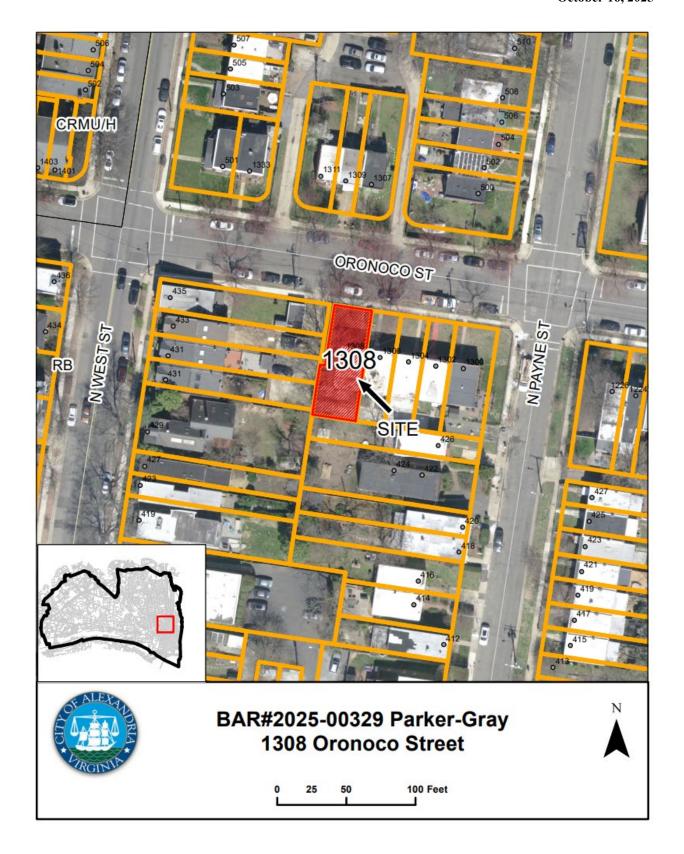

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends denial of the Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations.

GENERAL NOTES TO THE APPLICANT

- 1. APPEAL OF DECISION: In accordance with the Zoning Ordinance, if the Board of Architectural Review denies or approves an application in whole or in part, the applicant or opponent may appeal the Board's decision to City Council on or before 14 days after the decision of the Board.
- 2. COMPLIANCE WITH BAR POLICIES: All materials must comply with the BAR's adopted policies unless otherwise specifically approved.
- 3. BUILDING PERMITS: Most projects approved by the Board of Architectural Review require the issuance of one or more construction permits by Department of Code Administration (<u>including signs</u>). The applicant is responsible for obtaining all necessary construction permits after receiving Board of Architectural Review approval. Contact Code Administration, 703-746-4200 for further information.
- 4. ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF APPROPRIATENESS AND PERMITS TO DEMOLISH: Applicants must obtain a copy of the Certificate of Appropriateness or Permit to Demolish PRIOR to applying for a building permit.  issuance if the work is not commenced and diligently and substantially pursued by the end of that 12-month
 period.
- 6. HISTORIC PROPERTY TAX CREDITS: Applicants performing extensive, certified rehabilitations of historic properties may separately be eligible for state and/or federal tax credits. Consult with the <u>Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR)</u> prior to initiating any work to determine whether the proposed project may qualify for such credits.



I. APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

The applicant requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations (after-the-fact) to install a vinyl fence and gate enclosing the front yard.

Site context

The building is bound by Oronoco Street to the north and private development on all other sides. The fence is highly visible from Oronoco Street.

II. <u>HISTORY</u>

The two-story, two-bay, Colonial Revival style brick row house at 1308 Oronoco Street is the westernmost in a row of five matching houses and was built in **1961**, according to real estate records. It does not appear on the 1958 Sanborn Fire Insurance map but does appear on the 1965 Sanborn map. The five brick rowhouses on the 1300 block of Oronoco Street resemble their neighbors in the 1200 block of Oronoco Street, constructed in 1942, and are typical of the mid-20th century architectural language of solid, yet simple masonry rowhouse developments that were constructed to accommodate the population surges in the area during the mid-century.

On July 22, 2025, Staff received a complaint that an inappropriate fence had been installed at the subject property without BAR approval. Staff subsequently issued a violation letter to the property owner notifying them of the requirement to get BAR approval, and the applicant applied for a Certificate of Appropriateness.

Previous BAR Approvals None.

III. ANALYSIS

The applicant requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations (after-the-fact) to install a 4-foot-tall vinyl fence and gate enclosing the front yard.

According to the Fences, Gates + Walls chapter of the Parker-Gray *Design Guidelines*, "Fences and walls should be made of wood, metal, and/or masonry. The Board discourages using poured-in-place concrete or synthetic materials such as fiberglass or vinyl."

Additionally, according to §10-205(A)(2)(b)(3) of the Zoning Ordinance, in the Parker-Gray District, the BAR's review standards include "the compatibility of proposed alterations with other buildings on the block face or block face across the street, giving consideration to building size, shape, roofline, color, materials, texture, nature of openings, and architectural details." As such, staff visited the subject property to determine whether the vinyl fence is in keeping with the surrounding block face. Staff found that, on the south side of the 1300 block of Oronoco Street, all other properties had fences made of either metal or wood. On the north side of the street, there is one house with a vinyl fence, but notably it is located outside the boundaries of the historic district and is not subject to the same standards.

Based on the *Design Guidelines* and Zoning Ordinance review standards, staff finds that the vinyl fence uses an inappropriate material and is not in keeping with the surrounding block face. The use of vinyl as a fence material detracts from the architectural character of both the subject property and block, and if approved by the Board would set a negative precedent for the neighborhood. Staff therefore recommends **denial** of the Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations.

Zoning

- C-3 All secondary utilities serving this site shall be placed underground. (Sec. 5-3-3) (T&ES)

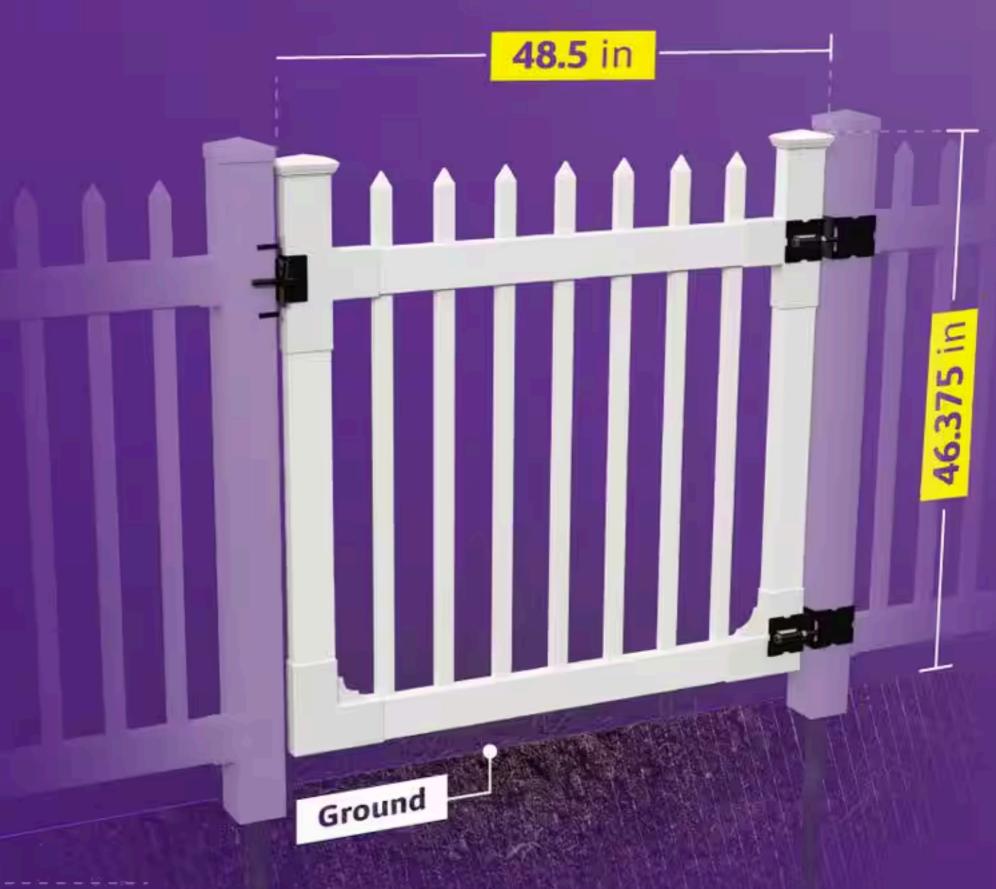

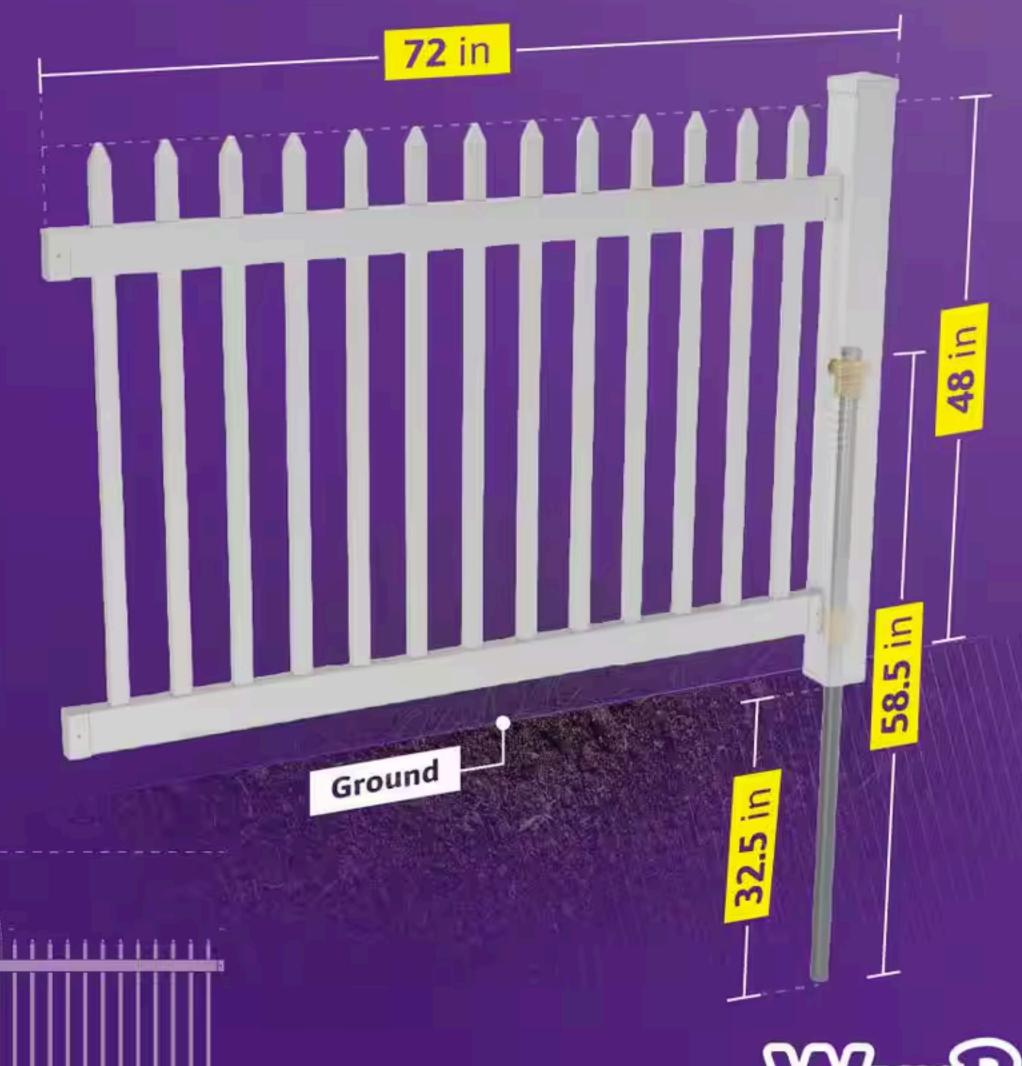
