Born in the UK, I'm a US citizen and have lived in the US since 2007 and in the City of Alexandria since 2012. Much of my career thus far has been in international conservation and development. Coming from an environmental science background (I have a PhD in ecological genetics) my work over the past 10 years has increasingly focused on climate change – from global modeling of its impacts to developing regional-to-local scale solutions, that all use nature to help local communities both mitigate and adapt to climate change. Given the breadth of the climate challenge, it means I have had the privilege to work across a wide range of environmental issues – from water (both too much and too little) to threatened species conservation to food security and farming. I have worked on the pure research side (in the lab and in the field), through now to organizational strategy, management and high-level communications and advocacy.
