9 AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 9-13-3 (TOWING AND STORAGE FEES AND
10 REGULATIONS) of Chapter 13 (TOWING AND STORAGE OF MOTOR VEHICLES) of Title 9
11 (LICENSING AND REGULATION) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as
12 amended.

14 Summary

15
16 The City Code currently sets the maximum fee that can be charged by private companies for towing
17 of a motor vehicle that weighs less than 7,500 pounds at \$135.00. Virginia Code § 46.2-1233 has
18 been amended to allow for the maximum fee for the tow of any passenger car to be \$150.00. This
19 Ordinance will update the City Code to reflect the maximum \$150 fee in the Virginia Code.
20 Furthermore, the City Code currently sets the maximum additional fees that can be charged by
21 private companies for towing of a motor vehicle between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. or on any
22 Saturday, Sunday, or holiday at \$25. Virginia Code § 46.2-1233 has been amended to allow for
23 these additional fees to now be a maximum of \$30. This Ordinance will update the City Code to
24 reflect the maximum of \$30 for additional fees in State Code.
