Born in Metter, GA

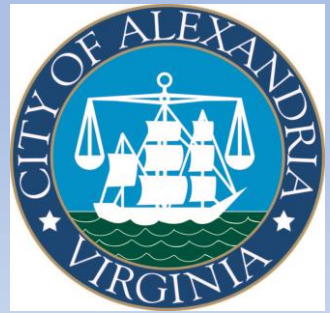
Oldest of nine children

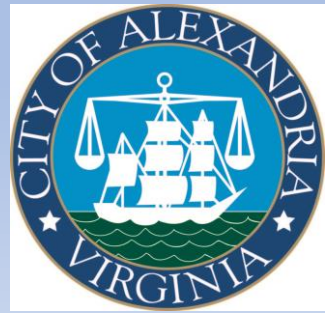

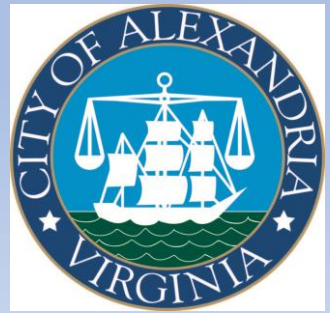
Married to John, had one child

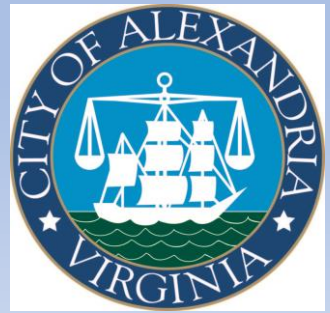

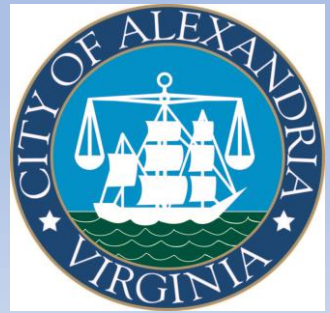


Lillian and her husband, Joseph J. Moraski, have lived in Alexandria for 70 years. With their family, attended Blessed Sacrament Church

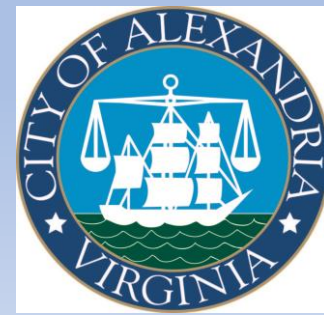


Was born in Alexandria Hospital and spent her entire life in Alexandria

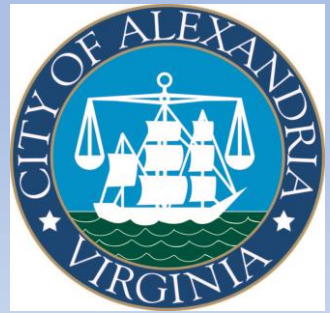
Grew up in South Dakota but was able to travel to Europe

Virginia Sahaj 101

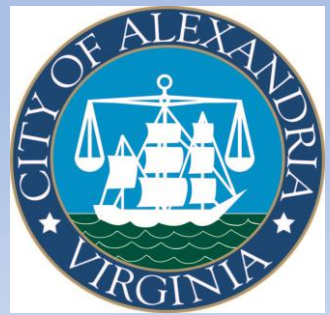


Main occupation was farming before going into nursing in the Navy

Ann Samuel 101

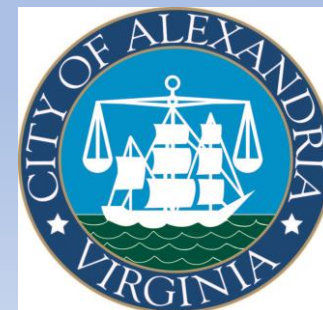
She was married to Robert Samuel for over 60 years. She is the oldest of 12 children.

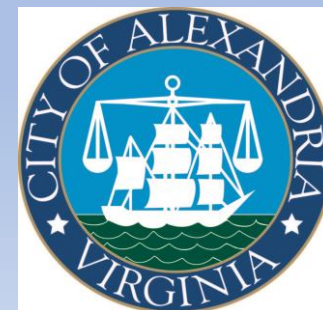
Grew up in Indiana

Juliette F. Tucker 101

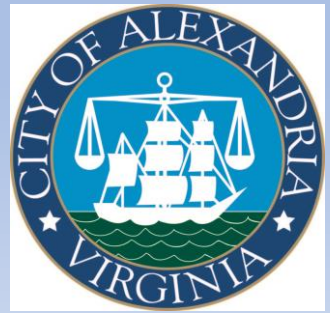


She was born in Schenectady, NY, to immigrant parents and was the middle of three sisters
