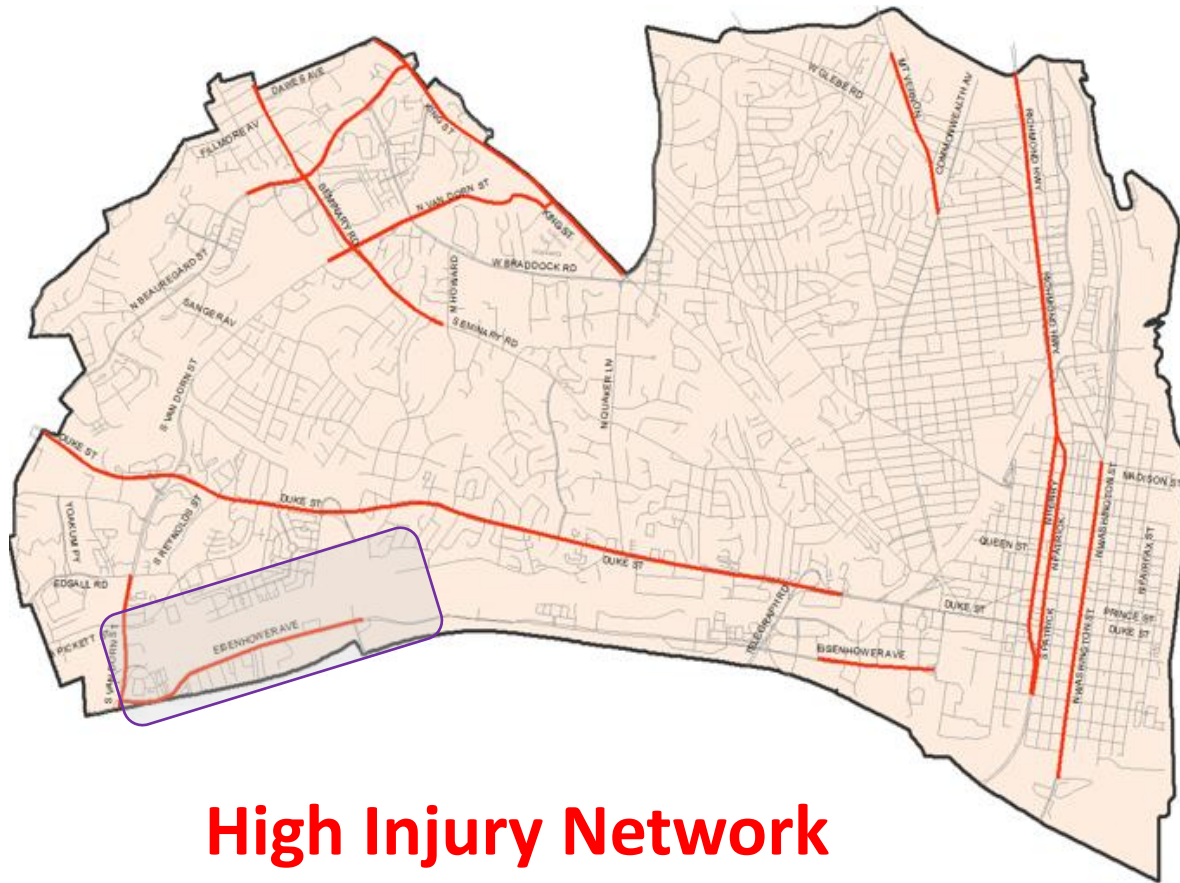
Safe Streets and Roads for All:

- Funding supports initiatives that **prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries**
- Eligible Grant Activities (\$1B available in FY24)
 - **Planning & Demonstration Grants**
 - Implementation Grants

Additional Information:

- \$100,000-\$10M award range for Planning and Demonstration grants
- 20% local match required
- Applications due August 29, 2024
- Award announcements expected by late 2024

Background



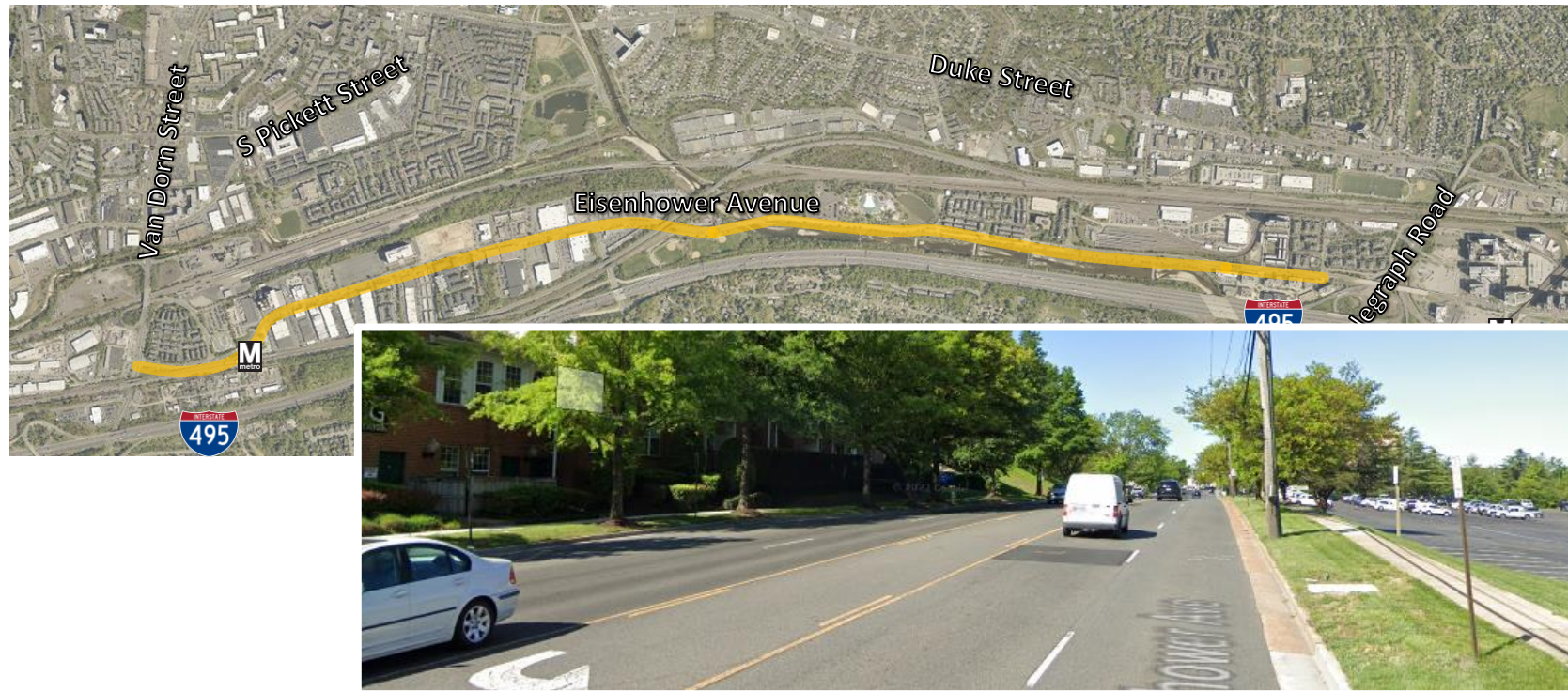
High Injury Network

- **Vision Zero Policy & Action Plan** adopted by City Council in 2017
- **Goal to eliminate fatal and severe crashes by 2028**

Recommended Project:

Safety & Mobility Improvements on Eisenhower Avenue

- Up to \$750K to implement safety & mobility enhancements between Mill Road and Metro Road.
- Follow-up to planning, analysis, and conceptual design as part of the VDOT Pipeline Eisenhower Transportation Study



Documented Issues

- Speeding & Cut-through traffic
- Substandard walkways and trails
- Limited and unsafe pedestrian crossings
- Poor access to and near Metro Stations
- Severe Crashes between Metro Road and Clermont Avenue

Recommendation
