

- Docketed Special Use Permit based on zoning violations





- Condition violations deemed request ineligible for administrative review
- Applicant requested docketed hearing with Planning Commission and City Council
- Condition violations have been resolved



- Extended hours of operation on Sunday until 10 p.m.

Key Findings and Recommended Conditions



- All violations had been resolved
- Use aligns with the Braddock Metro Small Area Plan
- Sunday closing hour of 10 p.m. is similar and the number of seats is lower when compared to two other similarly situated outdoor dining areas
- Total number of outdoor seats and hours of operation are lower than what can be requested through administrative SUP; Condition #26 recommends hours of operation until 10 p.m., daily
- Staff recommends a six-month review in Condition #25
