## Background: TOD Planning Pilot Grant Information



- U.S. DOT competitive grant program to support **comprehensive** or **sitespecific planning** associated with a transit capital investment or project
- US DOT will prioritize projects that address transit-oriented development (TOD) planning topics along a planned transit capital project, such as:
  - renewing our transit systems
  - advancing racial equity by removing transportation related disparities to all populations within a project area and increasing equitable access to project benefits
  - connecting communities by increasing access to affordable transportation options.



#### Grant Request Summary

Augment the Duke Street planning process with funding to support:

- Land use and housing analysis
- Economic analysis
- Infrastructure and transportation studies
- Open space planning
- Urban design
- Sustainability
- Community engagement and outreach
