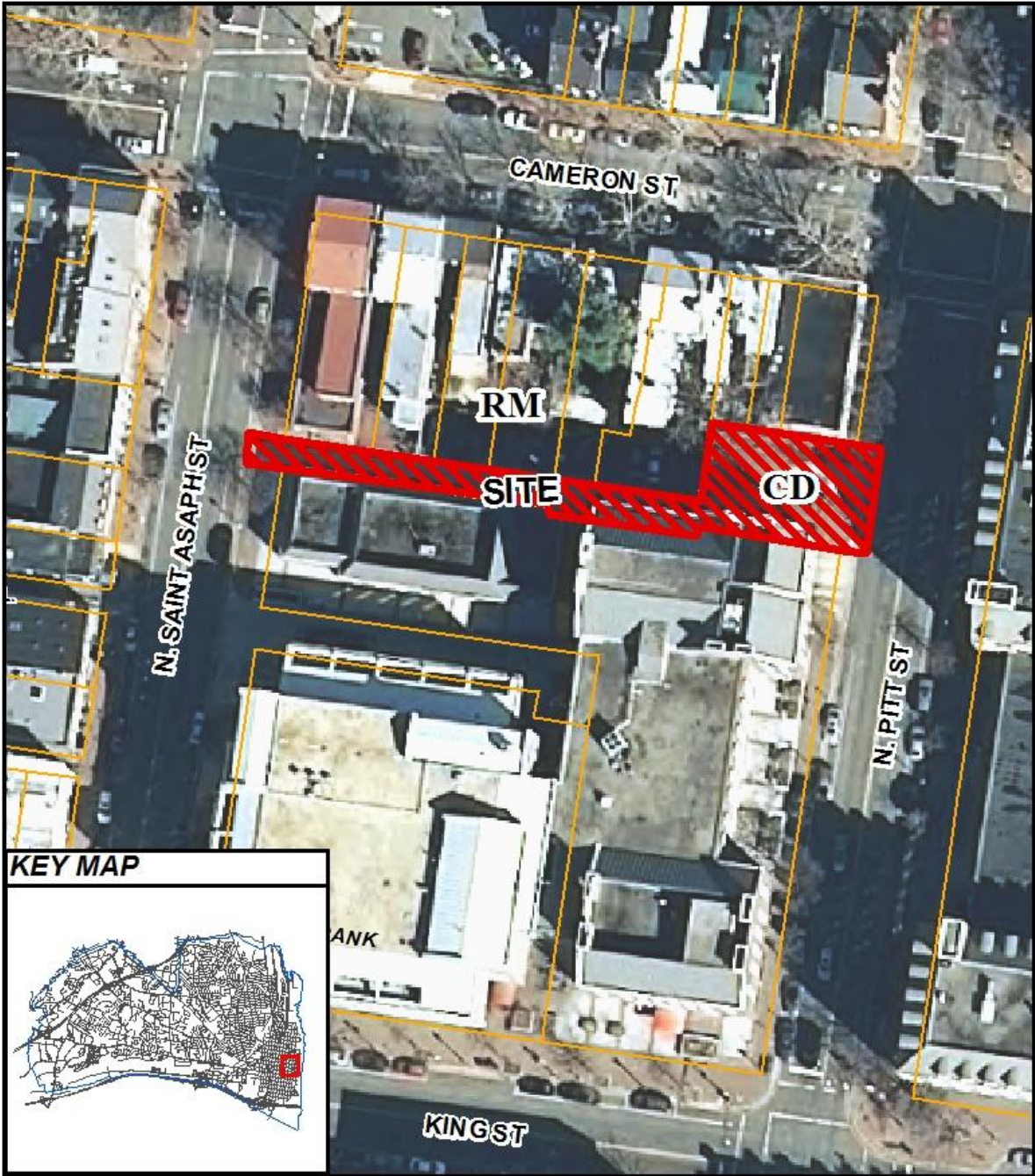

I. REQUEST

Periodically, the City reviews the Official Street Naming Map to ensure it is consistent with actual conditions and outside mapping agencies. In doing this review, staff discovered that an alley that is currently referred to as Washington Way was never officially named and recorded on the Official Street Naming Map. This alley is located in the 100 block between N. Saint Asaph Street and N. Pitt Street. A small pocket park called Washington Way Park is located at the northeast end of the alley. There are no current addresses for businesses or residences associated with this alley. In approving this street name, Washington Way would become the official name for this alley, which is consistent with what the alley has been traditionally called.

II. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends **approval** of the street name Washington Way for the unnamed alleyway between N. Saint Asaph and N. Pitt Streets. Since this is a new street name, the Planning Commission can make the final decision regarding the name of this street, per Section 5-2-64 of the City Code.
