WHEREAS, mentoring has been proven to build developmental assets in youth and improve mental health, increasing success in school and decreasing court-involvement; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Mentoring Partnership is committed to the vision that each of our children and young adults who needs a mentoring relationship will have one and that well-trained mentors and mentoring programs are available; and City employees are encouraged to serve as mentors for one hour during each work week; and

WHEREAS, an Alexandria Mentoring University will be developed to provide courses, trainings, and initiatives to equip caring adults with the skills to build our next generation of leaders and innovators; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has created the full-time position of Alexandria Mentoring Partnership Coordinator to ensure equitable standards are used and practiced throughout all partnering programs, and to enhance and expand mentoring throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria will do all it can to support the growth and quality of the mentoring experience for children and young adults, mentors and mentoring programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JUSTIN WILSON, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of January as:

“ALEXANDRIA MENTORING MONTH”

And affirm the commitment of the City of Alexandria to support Alexandria Mentoring Partnership initiatives in the City and I call this observance to the attention of all our residents.
