
# Subject Right-of-Way



# Background

- Created with 1892 subdivision, but was never improved
- Subject area is identified in Open Space Master Plan 2017-2026 Update
  - Identified as candidate for open space
    - Small lots in neighborhoods
    - Lands with significant natural features
    - Excess right-of-way



# Requested Vacations


## 406 and 408 East Alexandria

- Red added to 408

- Requesting the full subject area
- Magenta added to 404A





# City Council Vacation Criteria

- I. There is no use of the right-of-way at the time the application is filed. **NOT SATISFIED**
- II. No reasonable use of the right-of-way could exist in the future, either for its original purpose or for some other public purpose. Reasonable uses include, but are not limited to future roads, bike paths/trails, recreational facilities, open space, utilities or other environmental protections. **NOT SATISFIED**
- III. No portion of the public right-of-way shall become landlocked. **SATISFIED**
- IV. No abutting property owners shall become landlocked or have access substantially impaired. **CONDITIONALLY SATISFIED**
- V. The vacation shall provide a public benefit. **NOT SATISFIED**

# Staff Analysis

- Requests do not satisfy the established vacation criteria
  - Current and future use of the subject area
  - Identified in City's Open Space Master Plan
- Due to overlapping requests, a proportional vacation would be the recommended solution



# Staff Recommendation

- Denial of the vacation requests
- Retain the area as open space
