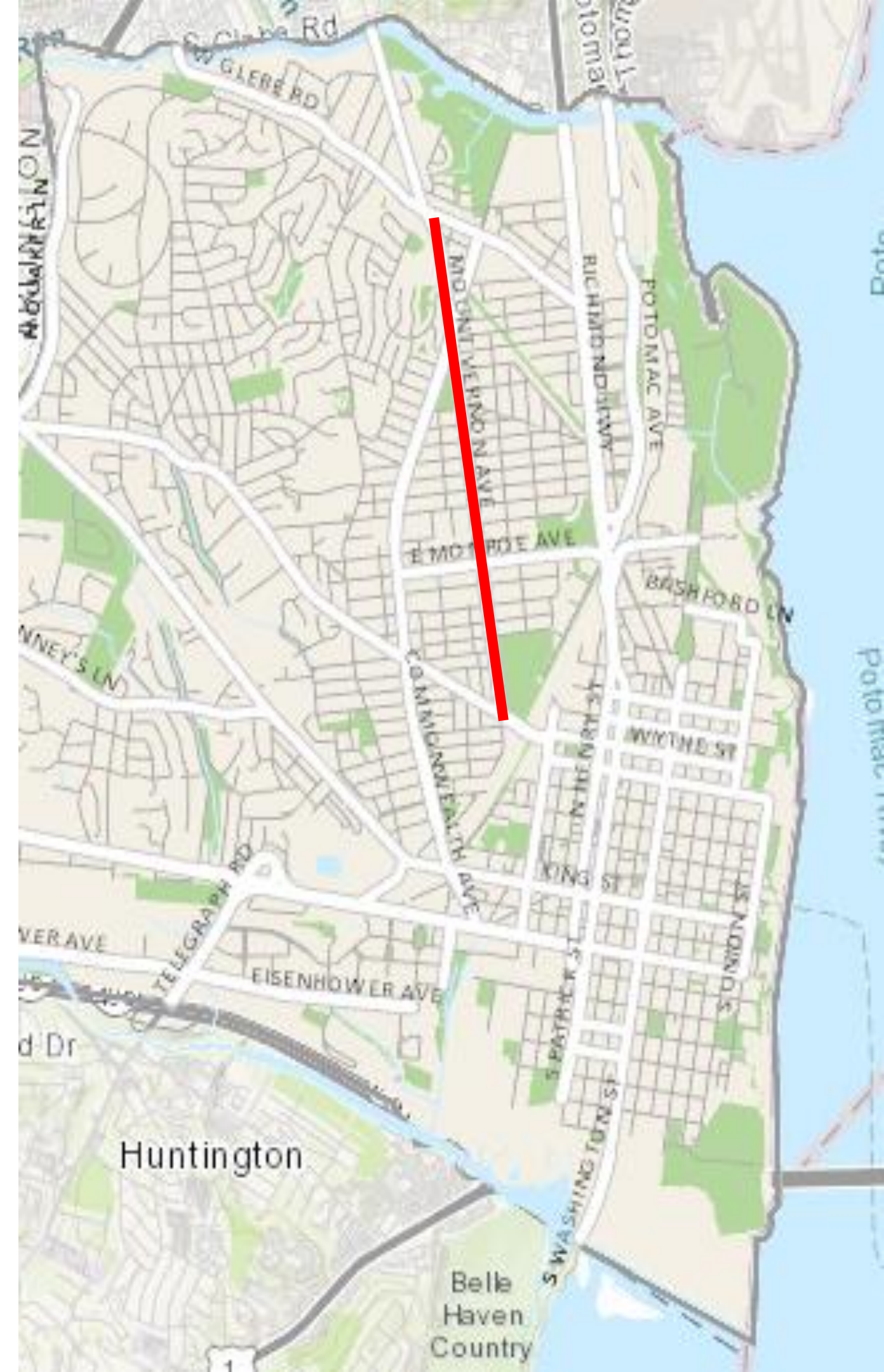

Background

▶ **Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOC) Technical Assistance Grants**

▶ **Transportation Land-Use Connections (TLC) Program** provides planning studies and work that promotes mixed-use, walkable communities and transportation alternatives.
▶ **Bicycle Network Gap Study**

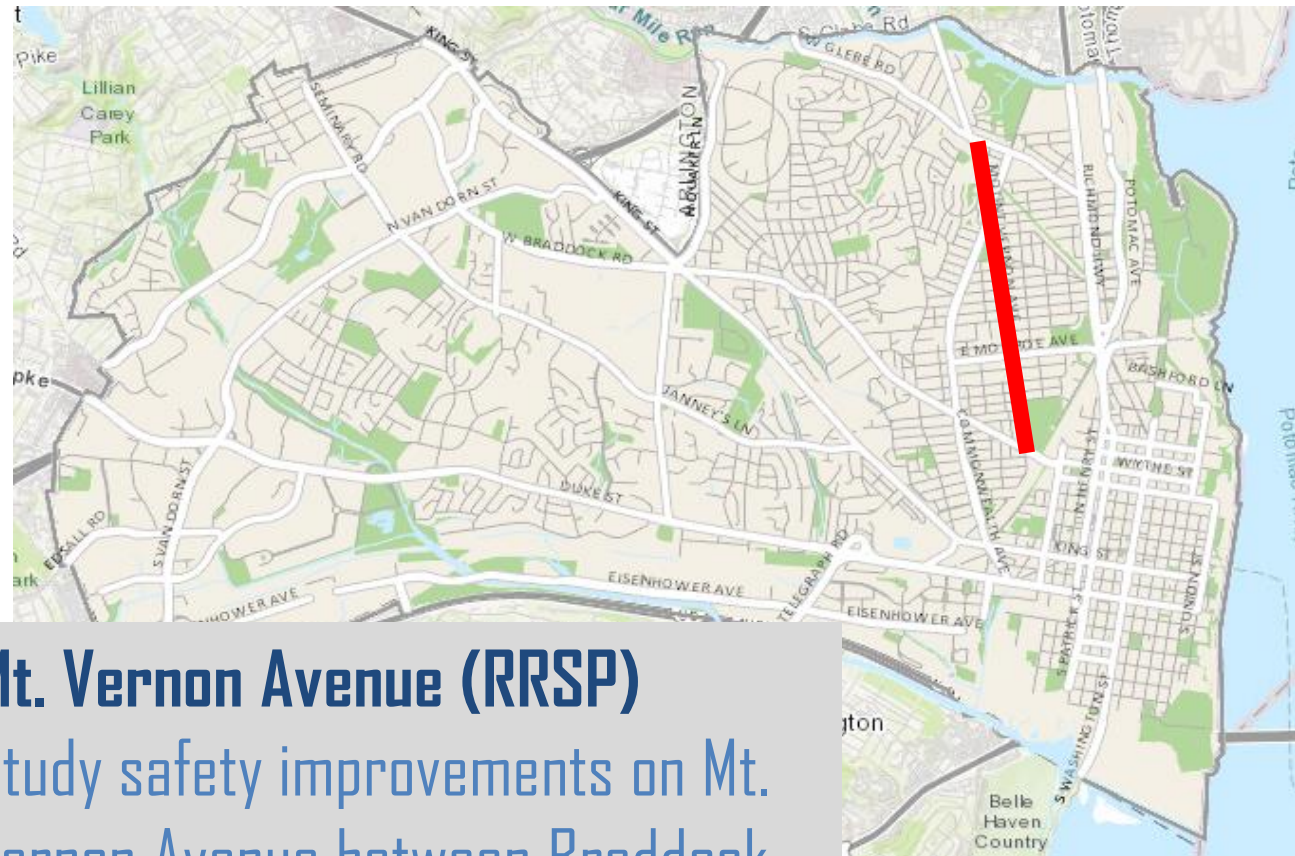
▶ **Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP)** provides planning preliminary engineering to address roadway safety issues to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes.
▶ **Mt. Vernon Avenue Safety Study**

Both MWCOC technical assistance grants:

- **Up to \$100,000 in short-term consultant services for planning**
- **Applications are due February 27, 2025**
- **If awarded, work starts fall 2026**
- **Work to be completed by June 30, 2027**

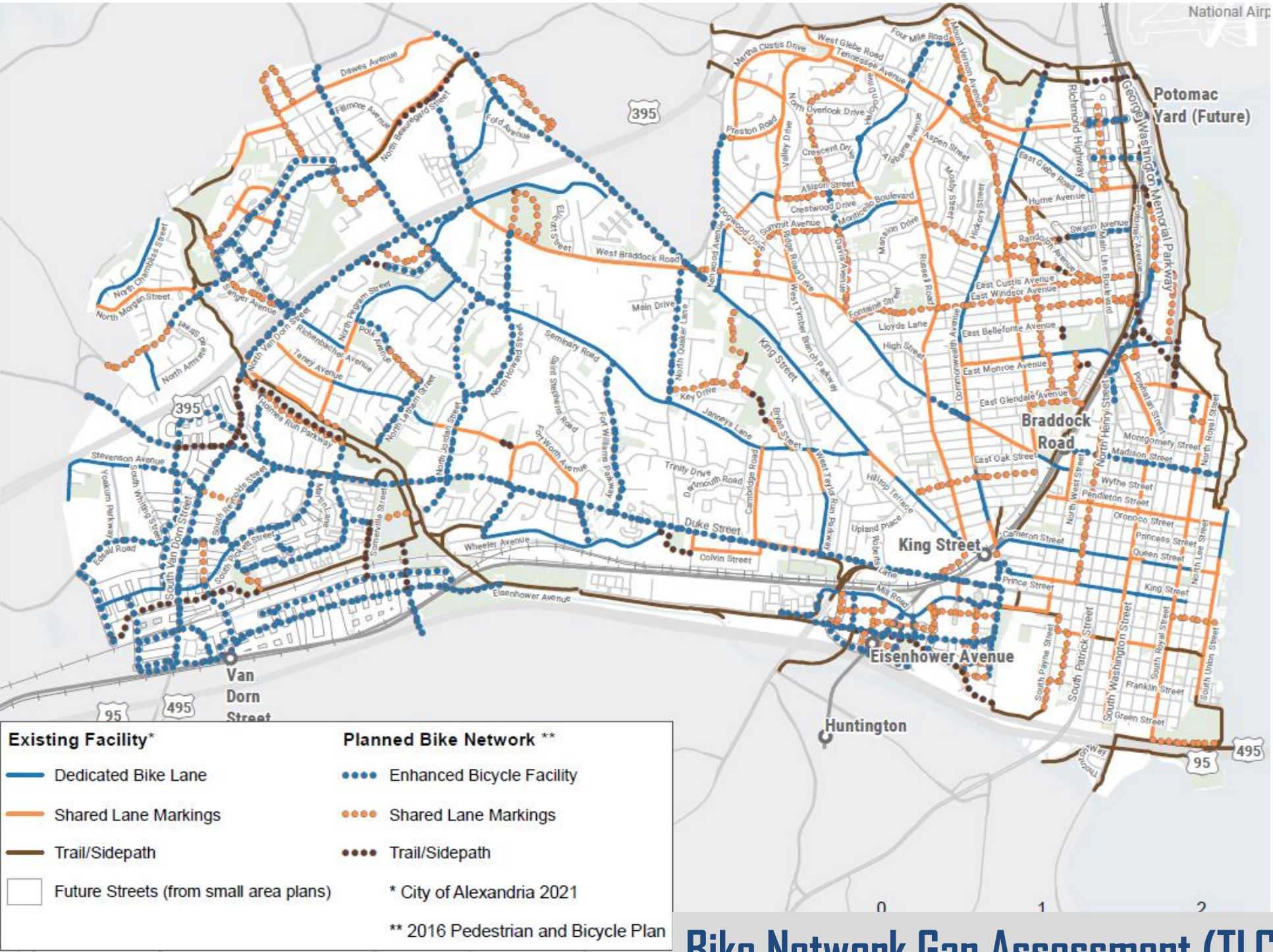


Project Locations

Bike Network Gap Assessment (TLC)

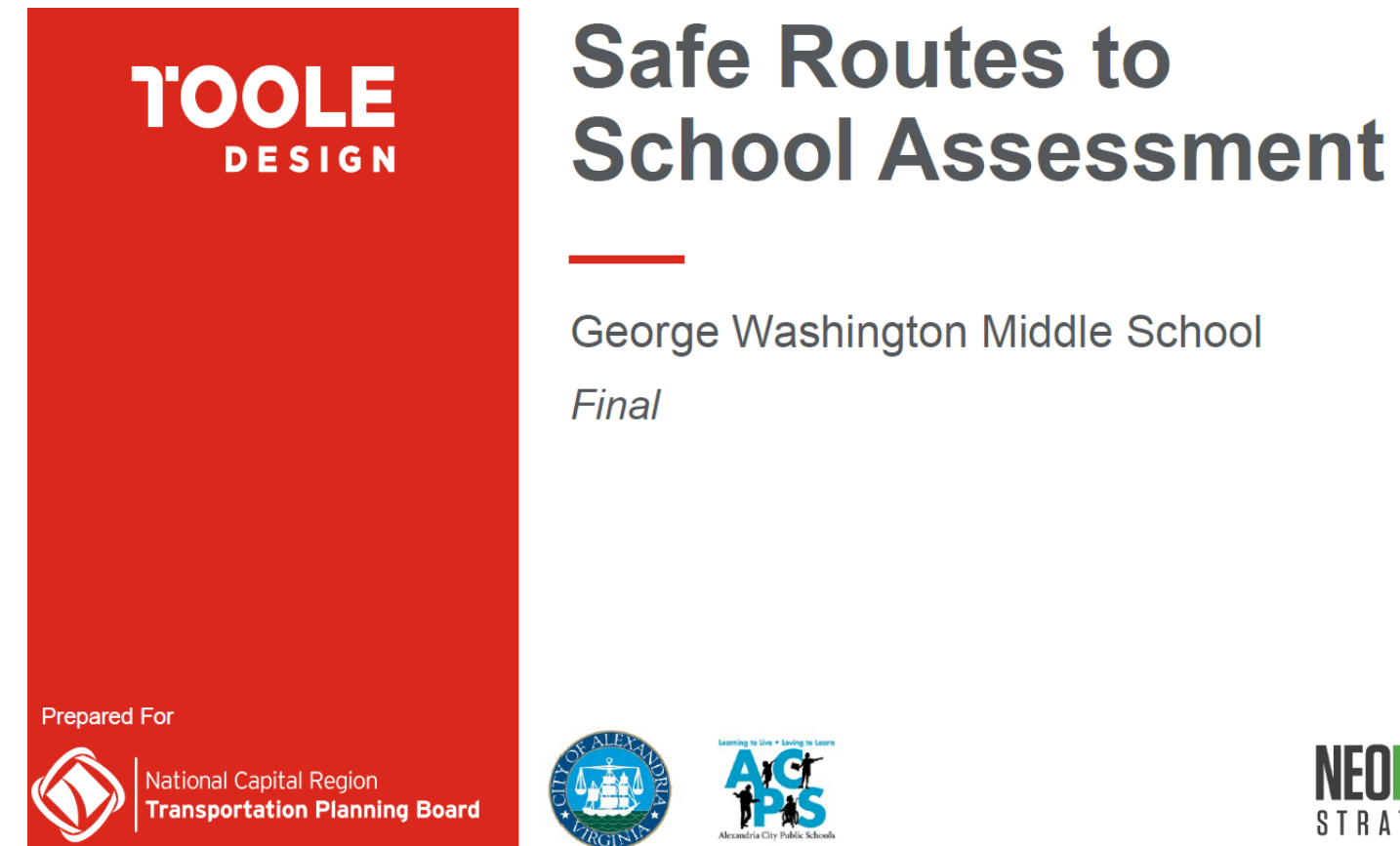
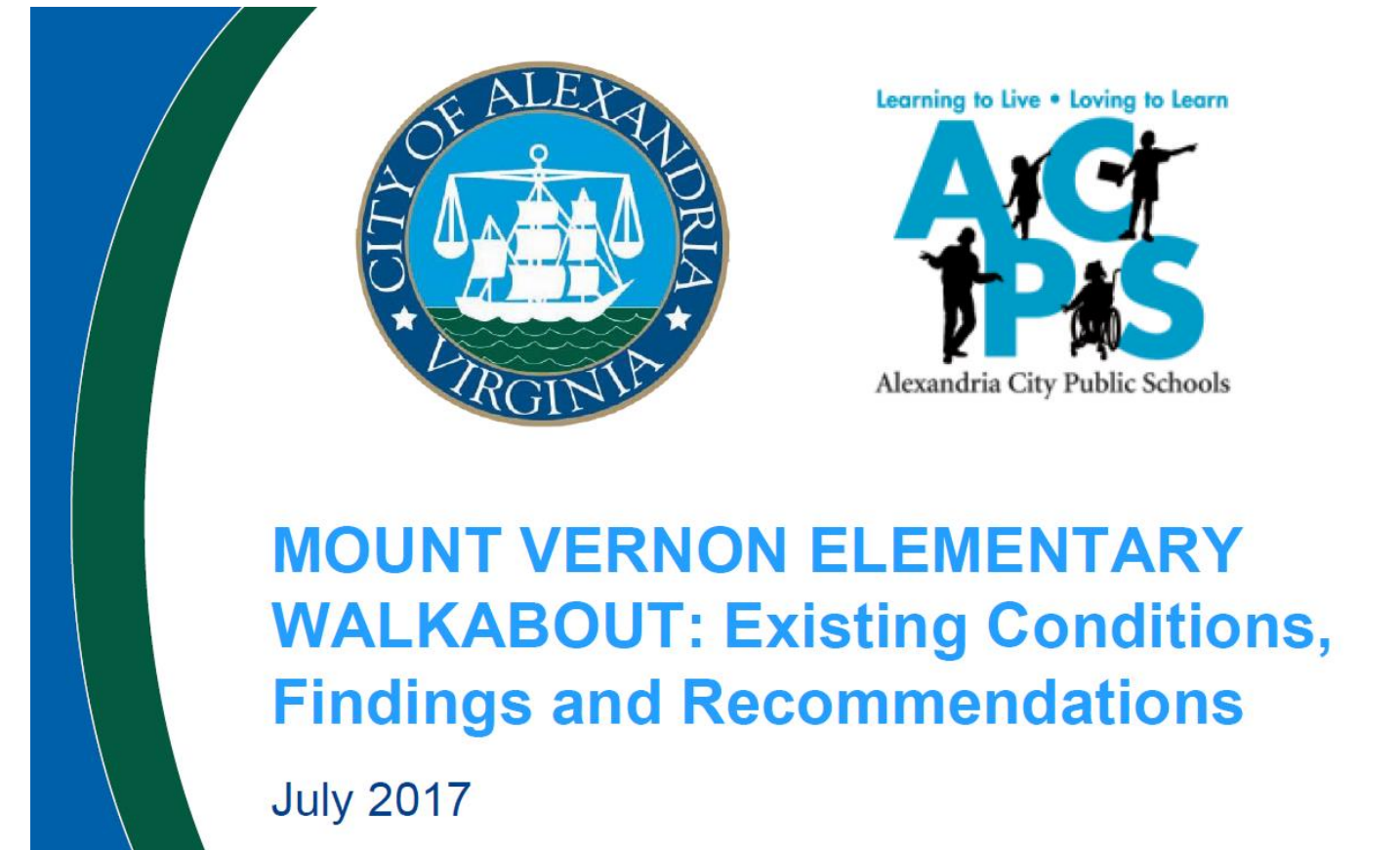
