




Project Location

Appeal of BAR Decision

"Failure to honor original guidance to appelant. Failure to conduct required analysis and misleading reporting of findings. Lack of clear standards and failure to apply reasonable person test.

Inappropriate application of BAR principles."

Key Factors

- House constructed between 1863 and 1877
- Subject windows installed early 20th century
- Windows moved to current location in 1952
- Windows may be removed and repaired
- These are only historic windows remaining

Council Action

City Council may affirm, reverse, or modify, in whole or in part the decision of the BAR.

Staff recomendation:

Staff recommends that the City Council <u>affirm</u> the decision of the Board of Architectural Review and <u>deny</u> the Certificate of Appropriateness for the replacement of two second floor windows on the south elevation of 201 Gibbon Street.
