Dear Members of the Selection Committee, I am writing to express my interest in serving on the Alexandria Housing Affordability Advisory Committee. I am a retail employee in Alexandria, somehow qualify as low income, and am currently navigating the housing search myself. This personal experience is what most strongly motivates my desire to serve on this committee and to contribute meaningfully to discussions around housing affordability. Like many people who work in Alexandria's service and retail sectors, I am deeply connected to this city but face real challenges finding housing that is affordable, stable, and close to my place of employment. Experiencing the housing market firsthand—long waitlists, limited availability especially for First Time Home Buyer allotted units, and rising rents—has given me a clear understanding of how difficult it can be for working residents to remain in the community they help support every day. In addition to my own experience, my work has allowed me to support low-income and second-chance employees, many of whom face even greater barriers to housing due to income constraints or past challenges. I regularly see how housing instability affects employee retention, financial security, and overall well-being. These experiences have reinforced my belief that housing policy must reflect the realities faced by working people and those rebuilding their lives. I also serve on the Board of the Del Ray Business Association, where I am engaged with local business owners and community members on issues affecting our neighborhood's vitality and inclusivity. This role has helped me better understand how housing affordability, workforce stability, and small businesses are interconnected, and it has strengthened my commitment to collaborative, community-driven solutions. I would be honored to bring both my lived experience and my community involvement to the Housing Affordability Advisory Committee. I am eager to listen, learn, and contribute thoughtfully to policies that help ensure Alexandria remains a place where people of all incomes can live, work, and thrive. My entire career has focused on providing opportunities and access for young people. For the past six years, I have done this through my work at Genesys Works, a national workforce development organization. While I started in a fundraising focused on government grants, I now report directly to the CEO as his Chief of Staff. While the organization is national, we have a local office serving the National Capital Region. We partner closely with Alexandria City High School to recruit, train, and offer paid year-long internships to seniors (with two current working interns, and three from the previous academic year). We have gotten great candidates from the school, and the school champion Sarah Black is a hugely supportive partner. However, we are limited to serving more students in Alexandria due to our challenges in securing internship opportunities for them that are close enough geographically to school or the Metro. I would love to work with this commission to continue finding innovative ways to advance existing partnerships, or to secure new ones, to support all residents in accessing the training and opportunities that they deserve to reach full employment, thereby furthering Alexandria's community to reach its fullest potential.

Professionally, I served for more than six years as a Budget Technician with WSSC Water, one of the largest public utilities in the region. In this role, I administered operating and capital budgets exceeding \$1 million, supported long-term capital improvement planning, produced GFOA-standard financial reports, and contributed to strategic sourcing initiatives that generated more than \$1.5 million in cost savings.
