WHEREAS, the Partnership proudly offers Caring University (CaringU) a free learning institute for youth and the adults who care about them, fostering social and emotional development, and a culture of caring across Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria remains deeply committed to investing in the growth, quality, and profound positive impact of the mentoring experience for youth, our dedicated mentors, and all partner mentoring programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALYIA GASKINS, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of January as:

“ALEXANDRIA MENTORING MONTH”
