I write to strongly endorse the re-appointment of ALLISON CRYOR DiNARDO as a Commissioner and Member of the Industrial Development Authority. Allison's continued service on the IDA is essential. Allison has applied for re-appointment. Allison is an exceptional technical expert, and she brings several perspectives to the IDA that the IDA, and the City, needs right now.

Allison is a former member of the Board of Visitors of the University of Virginia, and also served as a member of the Board of UVA's Alumni Association. Allison is the only IDA commissioner with direct personal experience in the financial management of a large, state-supported university - this expertise is vitally important to the City and will be indispensable over the next several years. Allison is also the former Chair of ACT, Chair of AEDP, and President of Volunteer Alexandria, and in those capacities, her familiarity with the City's non-profit and business development communities meets crucial IDA and City needs. Allison's exceptional preparation and facility with the IDA's technical, financial, and related subject-matter is visible at every IDA meeting and in everything that Allison does for the IDA.

Pursuant to state statutes, the IDA is composed of a fixed, term-staggered membership of seven (7) commissioners. Allison's reappointment will prevent an avulsive knowledge-gap that the IDA, and the City, simply cannot afford.

The IDA currently has one other vacancy (separate and apart from Allison's re-application).

I am Chair of the Industrial Development Authority; while I write purely in my personal capacity, I am certainly aware of no disagreement whatsoever within the IDA concerning Allison's reappointment.
