- Request Description: I can understand the City of Alexandria would like to collect additional revenue from those who visit Old Town Alexandria commercial establishments by extending paid meter hours. I believe having to pay for parking to go to dinner will have a negative effect on businesses in Old Town, but I understand the City of Alexandria has reviewed the potential effects and made the decision. However, I do not understand the logic of charging residents in the Carlyle area to park at nights and on weekends. There are not enough businesses in the area to justify extending the hours on all meters in the Carlyle area for those few patrons who come to conduct business at night and on weekends. In fact, many of the businesses are closed at night and on the weekends, as they cater to the Patent Office employees. Meter time extension will take its toll primarily on the residents. As stated, unlike Old Town, the Carlyle area is by far a residential area versus a business area at night and on weekends, and residents often have overnight guests who require parking. Overnight guests are unable to use two hour meters.
Therefore, I am unclear why the City of Alexandria is pursuing a plan to penalize its residents for choosing to reside in Alexandria.
Residents in other areas of Alexandria are eligible for parking stickers exempting them from city meters. If the City of Alexandria decides to extend parking meters in the Carlyle area to 9pm six days per week, will residents be offered city parking stickers?
