AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-4-161 (SAME—COMPOSITION) of Article U (ALEXANDRIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION) of Chapter 4 (COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS) of Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-4-161 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended by deleting the text shown in strikethrough and adding the text shown in underline as follows:

Sec. 2-4-161 – Same—composition.

The commission shall consist of ~~14~~13 members, appointed by the city council as follows:

- (1) two members from the planning commission, nominated by the commission;
- (2) one member from the traffic and parking board, nominated by the board;
- (3) one member from the environmental policy commission, nominated by the commission;
- (4) one member from the Alexandria Transit Company Board of Directors, nominated by the board, or a nominee of the Board;
- (5) two citizen members, who shall be residents of the city possessing qualifications in land-use, transportation and/or municipal finance, of whom one shall reside east of Quaker Lane and one west of Quaker Lane;
- (6) two, ex-officio, non-voting members from the city council, who shall be selected from among Council members who serve on the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Transportation Planning Board (MTCOG/TBP), Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NMTA), Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTTC) or the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA); ~~and~~
- (7) two additional citizen members in addition to those provided for in subsection (5) above, who shall be residents of the city, of whom one shall reside east of Quaker Lane and one west of Quaker Lane; ~~;~~
- (8) one citizen member, who shall be a resident of the city between the ages of 16 and 25, possessing an interest in or knowledge of transportation and land use planning issues; and
- (9) one member from the Commission on Aging or the Commission on Persons with Disabilities, nominated by the Commission, or their nominee.

Section 2. That Section 2-4-161 as amended pursuant to Section 1 of this ordinance, be, and the same hereby is, reordained as part of the City of Alexandria City Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
