
- Criteria for reviewing encroachment requests

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Background Information


- Existing Condition
 - Wall encroaches into public right-ofway
 - Existing sidewalk is 4.4' wide
- Prior Application
 - Grading plan previously approved
 - Did not include changes to wall
- Revised Application
 - Request to demolish and rebuild wall in current location

Requested Encroachment




Staff Analysis

- Requested encroachment does not meet City criteria
 - Limits the intended function of the right-of-way
 - Not a result of construction of historical error
 - Privatizes the right-of-way
- Staff recommends an alternative, limited encroachment
 - Cost and site impacts limited
 - Allows for work necessary to connect to neighboring wall, which would remain in place
 - Provides immediate public benefit of passing space along otherwise narrow sidewalk
