### **Project Details**

#### **City Hall Details**

- +/-106,969 SF renovated community and City office space
- Ground floor Council Chamber
- Preservation and restoration of exterior

#### **Market Square Site Design**

Flexible design for fountain,
 Farmers Market & events

#### Garage

- New construction
- Safer pedestrian connection to City Hall





### **Architecture – City Hall**

- Historically appropriate exterior rehabilitation of City Hall
- BAR review of City Hall exterior and Market Square design
- Design updates to 1961 addition (King Street façade)
- Expansion of fifth floor



### Site Design – Market Square

- New flexible water feature
- Expanded community gathering space
- Plaza will be more accessible
- Addition of two performance spaces
- Enhanced seating areas with new trees for shade
- Eliminated outdoor trash storage





### **Key Findings and Insights**

#### **Highlights:**

- City Hall: Complete renovation with ground level Council Chamber
- **Stormwater**: Phosphorous removal of up to 0.43, exceeding the 0.12 pounds requirement
- Transportation: DASH bus and King Street Trolley service, new bikeshare station, added bicycle racks, EV charging, and dedicated motor coach parking

#### **Benefits:**

- New public meeting and collaboration spaces
- Exterior rehabilitation of historic City Hall and rebuild of garage, new plaza and streetscape
- Public access to exterior restrooms and drinking fountains in City Hall
- Green building, public art, and bikeshare
