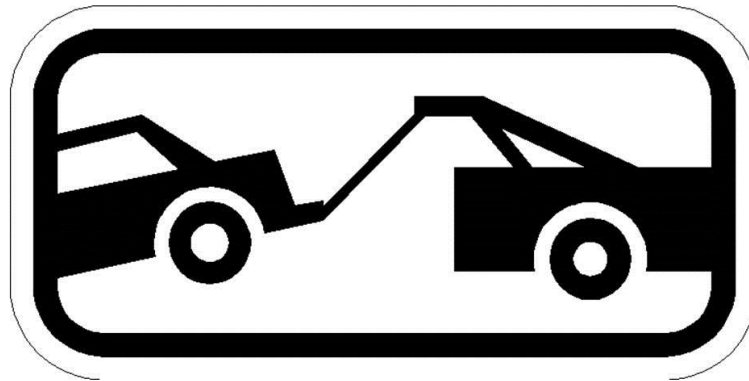




Towing Ordinance

Why Change Now?

- **The last code revision was in 1993.**
- **There are a number of issues that need to be addressed.**
- **Tow operators are not following the code.**

Towing Fees

	City Impound	Existing	Proposed
Standard Tow	\$125	\$75	\$125
Medium Tow			\$250
Heavy Tow			\$500
Storage	\$50		\$50
Storage Large Vehicles			\$5/ft.
Admin Fee	\$90		\$75
Drop Fee		\$25	\$50
After Hours		\$10	\$25

Vehicle Release

- **If violation is corrected before tow truck hook-up, no charge.**
- **If vehicle owner corrects violation after hook-up there will be a \$50 drop fee.**

Notice of Tow

- **City Manager shall promulgate regulations on how tow operators contact the City when towing a vehicle.**

Methods of Payment

Tow Operators must accept:

- **Cash**
- **Debit**
- **Credit**
- **Personal Check if debit/credit payments can't be processed.**

Warning Signs

- **Now allows standard 9"x18" sign rather than 4 square feet.**
- **The Department of Emergency Communications number must be on sign.**

9-13-11

Registration

- **New section requires tow truck operators to register with the City.**
- **Operators must provide a list of all the properties they tow from.**
- **City will issue operator certificates authorizing the tow operator to operate in the city.**

9-13-12



Staff is now able to assess Class Four Civil Violations

- **Property owner held accountable for towing violations related to their property.**
- **Towing operators also held accountable.**
