29	(b) <u>Costs</u>
30	(1) <u>In determining the reasonable expense of an appropriate emergency response, the</u>
31	City Manager or their designee may bill a flat fee as provided in Va. Code §
32	15.2-1716.1 or bill a minute-by-minute accounting of the actual costs incurred.
33	(2) As used in this section, "appropriate emergency response" includes all costs of
34	providing law-enforcement, firefighting, and emergency medical services.
35 36	(3) Unless otherwise provided in Va. Code § 15.2-1716.1, a person's liability may
30 27	not exceed \$2,500 in the aggregate for a particular incident that has occurred
37	pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
