Request

- Approve the attached Resolution to support the Round 6 Virginia Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF) grant applications; and
- Authorize the City Manager to submit this Resolution and enter into any agreements that may be required to receive these funds should the requested allocation be approved.

Key Elements

▶ Staff is seeking to submit a total of nearly \$3M in grant funding for two (2) Flood Action Alexandria flood mitigation projects.



Background Information

- Virginia Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF): Established in 2020 and managed by Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR)
 - To provide support for regions and localities to reduce impacts of flooding.
- ▶ CFPF Rounds 1 5: Awarded about \$200 million from 2020 2025.
 - City has been awarded about \$6.5 million for six projects
 - Requesting about \$3M for Round 6



Background Information

- ▶ CFPF Round 5 changes: \$50M in grants to the top scoring projects with \$17M in loans to five projects that were eligible for funding but ranked lower. (Focus was on grants for resilience plans Planning category.)
 - DCR awarded the City with two loans instead of grants.
 - Loans determined to not be financially beneficial.
 - DCR anticipates a greater allocation of funding for 'projects' instead of 'planning' during CFPF Round 6.
 - Recommendation: Resubmit the grant applications during Round 6



Phase 2 Four Mile Run and Hooffs Run Inlet Replacement

- Design and construction of approximately 120 previously identified inlets.
- Builds on work done with Round 3 CFPF grant for Phase 1.
- Project Cost Estimate = \$2,346,000.
- > 50/50 CFPF Grant Request = \$1,173,000.
- Previously submitted under Round 5.



Valley Drive Storm Drain Improvements

- Add a new storm sewer pipe system and new curb inlets along Crestwood Drive.
- Realign storm sewer pipe at Dogwood Drive.
- Increase storm drain inlet capacity along Valley Drive.
- Project Cost Estimate = \$3,600,000.
- > 50/50 CFPF Grant Request = \$1,800,000.
- Previously submitted under Round 5.



Recommendations

- Consideration to submit for Round 6 of Virginia's Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF) Grant Application due October 2025.
- Phase 2 Four Mile Run and Hooffs Run Inlet Replacement
 - Request up to \$1,173,000, or 50% match, of the total project cost of \$2,346,000. Local match funded by Stormwater Utility Fee.
- Valley Drive Storm Drain Improvements
 - Request up to \$1,800,000, or 50% match, of the total project cost of \$3,600,000. Local match funded by Stormwater Utility Fee.



Recommendation That City Council:

- Approve a Resolution to support the grant applications; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to take steps necessary to receive the grant funds.
