Introduction and First Reading. Consideration. Passage on First Reading of an Ordinance to Increase the Impound Service Charge and the Impound Lot Storage Fee

..BODY

ISSUE: Consideration of a proposed ordinance to increase the impound service charge and the daily impound lot storage fee.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council adopt the attached proposed ordinance to increase the impound service charge and the daily impound lot storage fee on first reading, and set it for public hearing on April 13, 2013 and final passage on May 6, 2013.

DISCUSSION: The proposed ordinance increases charges for motor vehicles impounded by the City. Currently, the impound service charge is \$80 and the impound storage fee is \$40 per day. As part of the FY 2014 proposed budget; the impound service charge is \$90 and the impound storage fee is \$50 per day.

FISCAL IMPACT: The increase of the impound service charge and the impound storage fee will generate approximately \$48,000 in additional general fund revenue annually.
