#### **Statement of Interest**

I am applying for reappointment to the Alexandria Renew Board. I've been a member of the Board since March 2016, and Vice Chair since 2022, serving on the Board's Finance and Audit committee, and chairing the Board's Governance committee since 2022. Since 2022, I've also been a member of the River Renew Council-Board workgroup, along with Alex Renew Chair John Hill, Mayor Justin Wilson, and Vice-Mayor Amy Jackson. My time on the Alex Renew Board has been one of great change. We've overseen the River Renew tunnel project, from the 2018 regulatory transfer of the City's storm outfalls to Alex Renew in 2018, to the completion of the tunnel and underground facilities in 2024. In the past two years, we hired a new Chief Executive/ General Manager and developed the Lifeline Emergency Assistance Program (LEAP) to benefit community members facing financial challenges paying their wastewater bills. In 2024, the Governance Committee developed, and the Board adopted, Alex Renew's first Environmental Justice policy. We continue to develop and implement guidance on the inclusion of environmental justice considerations, procedures, and outcomes in appropriate AlexRenew programs. We've also continued a robust program of engagement with the neighborhood associations, citizens' groups, and varied communities in the city. The next few years will be a time of challenge and opportunity for Alex Renew as we pursue our goals of equity and affordability for our diverse ratepayers, provide needed capital improvements to maintain and improve our facilities, evaluate alternatives to mitigate capacity issues in the Commonwealth Interceptor (a separate sanitary sewer that is owned and operated by Alex Renew), and make our facilities more climate resilient. We have a responsibility to our ratepayers to continue to pursue our mission, "to treat wastewater to protect public health and the waterways that connect us" in ways which also address the needs of Alexandria's diverse communities. An Alexandria resident since 1987, I am an active member of the Old Presbyterian Meeting House, having served multiple terms as an Elder on the church board. I'm also a long-time member of the Del Ray Civic Association. My professional experience includes over thirty years of infrastructure design and project management in both the public and private sectors. Serving on the Alexandria Renew Board has allowed me to combine my professional and technical experience with my commitment to environmental sustainability and my appreciation of our area's natural resources. I would appreciate the opportunity to continue to give back to the Alexandria community as a member of the Alex Renew board, as we work toward achieving a fishable, swimmable Potomac.

As a proactive leader, I believe in creating forums for dialogue between utilities and the community it serves, ensuring that residents feel informed and empowered regarding their water resources, especially as masterfully demonstrated in the Four Mile Run facilities. I offer a Master of Public Health, focused on environmental health, and an undergraduate degree in Chemistry. My professional experiences have allowed me to build subject matter expertise, including completion of AWWA's "Water Treatment Operator – Level 1" coursework, with Level 2 coursework in progress. My experience working in construction and time with the American Red Cross have afforded me my OSHA-30, Competent Industrial Rescuer, and other EHS-relevant certifications. I offer significant first-hand experience with crisis management and have completed FEMA's basic through advanced incident management trainings.

#### **Summary of Work and Experience**

My resume offers a variety of intersectional experiences to support my application. I served as a volunteer and an Americorps employee to the American Red Cross, facilitating resiliency and emergency response efforts in a 7-county region of Texas. In this role, I led our regional sheltering response to Hurricane Harvey and partnered with stakeholders at the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), Brazos Valley Council of Governments, and Homeland Security Advisory Council (HSAC) to improve the regional posture for contingencies. I worked in critical infrastructure, developing and implementing renewable construction projects, affording me an understanding of the complexities of capital improvement efforts and the challenges with underground utilities. In this role, I led environmental functions on multiple projects, including NPDES permit compliance, SWPPP implementation to prevent discharges and general regulatory compliance. I also led the safety function across these projects, providing trainings and coaching for a transient workforce, and facilitated organizational process improvement efforts for workforce development including improved onboarding processes. Currently, I lead regulatory advocacy efforts for the Association of Metropolitan Water Agencies, a trade association focused on drinking water policy. In this role, my expertise offers overlap with wastewater priorities including contaminants of concern like PFAS. I am a member of the sector coordinating council, supporting sector security and resilience efforts within the sector, and while my focus is on the Safe Drinking Water Act, I regularly engage with Clean Water Act regulation.
