The Historic Alexandria Resources Commission, the City Council's Commission chartered to advise the City Council on the responsible stewardship of our unique historic city, is writing to express our concern about the potential imminent threat of the Zoning for Housing/Housing for All project to the Town of Potomac National Register Historic District.

As you are probably aware, the Town of Potomac Historic District was added to Preservation Virginia's Most Endangered Historic Properties List in May. This endangered places program was initiated in 2000 to help raise awareness about threatened historic places in the Commonwealth. The listing for the Town of Potomac National Register Historic District states: *"Today, the 1,840-acre historic district includes a concentration of residences, including an eclectic collection of foursquares, Bungalows (many Sears kit houses), Colonial Revival, Folk Victorian, Mediterranean Revival, modified Queen Anne, and Tudor Revival houses, that are pleasantly arranged in a comfortable pedestrian and development scale."*

Over 75 houses in the Town of Potomac Historic District have been demolished in recent years. The Preservation Virginia listing identified an immediate threat of such tear-downs and the oversized and out-of-character houses that often replace them.

In addition to that threat, HARC's immediate concern is the fact that the preliminary zoning maps for the Zoning for Housing/Housing for All project showed projections of increased height and density within the boundaries of the Town of Potomac National Register Historic District, particularly along Mount Vernon Avenue.

As staff develops its proposals, which we understand will be released in early September, we urge you to direct staff to respect the historic character of this vibrant and low scale historic neighborhood of the Town of Potomac National Register Historic District.
