11 Title

12 AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-2-11 (ESTABLISHMENT OF
13 CENTRAL ABSENTEE VOTER ELECTION DISTRICT) all of Chapter 2
14 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code of the City of
15 Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

17 Summary

19 The proposed ordinance permanently adds the Charles E. Beatley, Jr. Central Library as a
20 Satellite Absentee Voter Election Office to be used in all general and primary elections in
21 addition to the current permanent Central Absentee Voter Election Precinct at 132 North
22 Royal Street. Currently the Charles E. Beatley, Jr. Central Library serves as a Satellite
23 Absentee Voter Election Office for November elections only.

41 Estimated Costs of Implementation

43 Costs to staff this additional satellite absentee voting office for primary elections range
44 from \$6,000 to \$16,000 depending on the number of days the office will be open for
45 voting. Additionally, a new, part-time employee could be needed to supplement the
46 existing staff of the General Registrar’s Office. If needed, any request for a new, part
47 time employee will be made in the next fiscal year and would cost approximately
48 \$45,000.
