**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATION FOR METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON
COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TRANSPORTATION-LAND USE CONNECTIONS
PROGRAM FOR FY 2026**

WHEREAS, the Transportation-Land Use Connections (TLC) Program is administered by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG); and

WHEREAS, the TLC Program is intended to fund short-term consultant services to local jurisdictions for small planning projects that promote mixed-use, walkable communities and support a variety of transportation alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the TLC Program provides up to \$80,000 in technical assistance for planning projects; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council adopted the Alexandria Mobility Plan in 2021, which aims to improve mobility, access, safety, and convenience for all users; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council adopted the AlexWest Small Area Plan in 2024, which calls for a future multi-modal transportation network; and

WHEREAS, North Beauregard Street is one of the corridors on the City's High Crash Corridor Network based on crash data analysis in the Vision Zero Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council desires to submit an application to the TLC Program for up to \$80,000 for Fiscal Year 2026 for the Beauregard Trail Feasibility Study; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby supports the application for up to \$80,000 from the TLC Program from MWCOG for Fiscal Year 2026.


