

**Old Town Civic Association endorses the appointment of Robert Cvejanovich
to the Board of Architectural Review for the Old & Historic District of Alexandria**

To the Mayor and members of the Alexandria City Council:

The Old Town Civic Association endorses Robert Cvejanovich for appointment to one of the seats to be held by a registered architect on the Board of Architectural Review for the Old & Historic District of Alexandria.

The following summarizes Robert's professional background and his interest in serving on the BAR.

Robert graduated from the Tulane University School of architecture in 1976 with a master's degree in architecture and has been a practicing architect since then. He currently is licensed in seven jurisdictions: Virginia, the District of Columbia, Maryland, Texas, Louisiana, North Carolina, and Connecticut.

Robert has worked on many historic buildings in the Washington area, including but not limited to, the Capitol Building, Supreme Court, Senate and House office buildings, the Library of Congress, Patent Office building, the National Air and Space Museum, and The White House. Robert also has done a lot of work with the Veterans Administration's National Cemetery Administration working on projects at more than twenty cemeteries. All VA cemeteries are on the National Register of Historic Places; any work associated with them requires compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1996.

Robert also has worked on several FEMA projects related to the preservation of historic places. He was part of the mitigation assessment team that went to the Gulf Coast and New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina. He also has written portions of a FEMA report regarding the effect of storms on historic properties as well as steps to take to preserve historic properties prior to potential natural disasters. In particular, Robert worked in the Yarmouth neighborhood in Norfolk, Virginia, which has been subject to flooding, on how to raise those properties out of the floodplain while maintaining their historical integrity.

Robert has lived in Alexandria for 24 years, and the past seven in Old Town, on South Royal Street. Robert has not done any architectural work in Old Town and therefore will not have a conflict-of-interest with regard to any projects coming

before the BAR that would require his recusal from discussing or voting on those projects. This is an important consideration in Robert's favor as oftentimes architect-members of the BAR have had to recuse themselves from the discussion of a specific project, thereby depriving the BAR of their technical expertise with regard to that project.

Robert would bring to the BAR not only his professional architectural experience, especially with regard to the preservation and enhancement of historic properties, but also a strong desire to preserve and enhance Old Town's historic character and its appeal to residents as well as to visitors.

OTCA would appreciate the support of every member of Council for Robert's appointment to the BAR for the Old & Historic District. Robert looks forward to this opportunity to serve his community.
