

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by Charter Section 2.03(k) to charge for parking in City owned parking lots and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by City Code Section 5-8-112 to establish parking meter lots; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by City Code Section 5-8-112 to designate the location of the lots, the hours and rates to be used for the meters in the lots, and any other necessary regulations for such meters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is necessary and proper at this time to install parking meters in the City parking lot at Union Station, located at 110 Callahan Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to proceed with all steps necessary to implement and operate meters in the City parking lot at Union Station at 110 Callahan Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA

1. That the following described parcels of the city that are used for off-street parking are hereby approved for parking meters: 110 Callahan Drive; and
2. That the parking meter hours for this parking lot be in effect 24 hours a day every day of the week; and
3. That the rate shall be \$2.50 per hour up to a maximum of \$15 per day at all metered spaces within the parking lot, which does not include any convenience fee that may be charged by the service provider for the pay by phone parking payment option; and
4. That the maximum time limit for parking in any space in this parking lot shall be ten days; and
5. That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to take such additional actions as may be necessary or convenient to establish the metered parking lot, set parking meter hours, the maximum time limit, and rates for parking, and determine the number of metered spaces as set forth by this Resolution; and
5. That the City Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to affix the seal of the City to such documents as may be necessary or convenient to implement this Resolution; and

6. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
