City Code Changes Evaluated

• Taxi Fares (Increase)

- Set a fare maximum and require Mobility Data Specifications (MDS)
- Remove City from setting fares altogether
- Vehicle Age Requirements (eliminate)
- Trade Dress (relax or maintain)
- Biennial Review (reduce frequency)
- Dispute Resolution (eliminate)
- Insurance Requirements (reduce or maintain)



City Code Changes Proposed

- Taxi Fares (Increase)
 - Increase initial meter fare from \$4 to \$5
 - Raise the per mile charge from \$2.16 to \$2.56
- Vehicle Age Requirements (Eliminate)
- Trade Dress (Maintain)
