Dear Ms. North:

This is to request that the City of Alexandria begin the process for establishing District 12 Overnight Parking Restrictions in Lincolnia Hills in the City's West End. Attached are 8 petitions from our residents and neighbors requesting the implementation of these restrictions on the following block faces:

- Anderson Street
- Banks Place
- Lomack Court
- Lowell Avenue
- Nagy Place
- N. Ashton Street (800 & 900 blocks)
- N. Morgan Street (6000, 6100 and 6200 blocks)

Over the past few years we've seen a marked increase in the encroachment of non-resident overnight parking on our streets. Generally, the non-residents begin moving their vehicles to our neighborhood @11:00 pm and leave them there until shortly before the District 12 Daytime Parking Restrictions begin at 8:00 am. This results in vehicles being parked bumper-to-bumper on both sides of the street. Drivers are left with a single navigable lane – for all intents and purposes, a "parking gauntlet". Those driving in opposite directions have virtually nowhere to pull over to avoid each other. The blocks that are immediately affected by this encroachment are:

- N. Morgan Street: the section of N. Morgan Street between Anderson Street and N. Ashton Street runs uphill in a tight curve. Overnight parking encroachment has created an extremely dangerous driving situation here because oversized vehicles such as moving vans, the #7 Metrobus, fire engines and ambulances are barely able to squeeze through the available roadway. Drivers (including some Metrobus drivers) have been known to back down the curve to avoid a collision. Residents have told us that vehicles are frequently parked so close to their driveways that they can't see past them to pull onto N. Morgan Street.
- Anderson Street: this street forms an inverted V. Overnight parking encroachment has
  created an extremely dangerous driving situation here because vehicles are parked
  bumper-to-bumper on both sides of the road, again allowing only a single lane of
  navigable roadway. Vehicles approaching the crest of the hill from opposite directions
  can't see each other until they're practically on top of each other. At that point, they
  usually don't have any open space to turn into and must sometimes back down the street
  to avoid a collision.
- Lomack Court: this street intersects Anderson Street at its crest. Non-residents park their vehicles right up to the corners (and, occasionally, *right on the corner*) Residents must pull out into Anderson Street at its crest to see if it's safe to proceed, adding more vehicles to an already dangerous scenario. Also, the 5900 block of Lomack Court is a

dead-end street, without the bulb that forms a cul-de-sac on the 6000 side of Lomack Court. Because they're unable to make a U-turn at the end of the 5900 block, the non-residents back down this narrow street to park bumper-to-bumper along its curbs.

We're requesting inclusion of the remaining streets because of their proximity to N. Morgan Street and Anderson Street. We've already seen overflow non-resident parking on Banks Place, Lowell Avenue, N. Ashton Street at its base and N. Morgan Street above N. Ashton Street. Many of the non-resident vehicles' owners come from the Woodmont Park apartments across Beauregard Street. According to the apartment complex's website, visitors must vacate their parking lot by 9:00 pm (it suggests that they move to N. Morgan Street). They're already walking (or being dropped off) as far as a half-mile from their apartments to park on our streets. If they can't park on a street once the restrictions are in place, we have every expectation that they'll simply move on to the closest non-restricted streets. After all, if they're currently willing to walk a half-mile, requiring them to walk another block won't deter them from parking on these other adjacent streets. So, in the interest of efficiency, we request that these streets be included in the overnight parking restrictions as well.

When we discovered the existence of the District 12 Overnight Parking Restrictions we thought establishing them on the 7 streets noted above would help reduce this problem. We've circulated petitions among the residents of the 7 streets under consideration and have attained the required 67% approval rate. In addition, we've circulated "supplemental" petitions among residents in our community who don't live on the streets under consideration, but who use them and have direct experience in trying to navigate through this congestion. When the Civic Association conducted several internal surveys of the vehicles parked on our streets overnight, it found that more than 50% of them did not display City of Alexandria decals on their windshields. We've also taken pictures of this congestion and have included some of them with our request.

With the exception of Lowell Avenue, all of the streets included in our request already participate in the District 12 Daytime Parking Restrictions. Their residents are familiar with the concept and already have visitor hang tag passes. Most of our block faces are based on the District 12 Daytime Parking Restriction block faces, however, I believe we also meet the requirements for block faces defined in City code.






