RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR FY 2032 CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY AND REGIONAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FUNDS


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria desires that the City submit an application to Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) for up to \$5,200,000 in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) and Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds for FY 2032; and

WHEREAS, \$3,200,000 of these funds are requested to fund safety improvements at the intersections of Duke Street and Route 1, \$1,000,000 requested for Capital Bikeshare, and \$1,000,000 requested to fund safe streets studies;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby supports this application for an allocation of up to \$5,200,000 in FY 2032 through CMAQ and RSTP; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council hereby grants authority for the City Manager to apply for these funds and execute project administration agreements, as well as other documents necessary for approved projects using these funds.
