Dear Mayor Gaskins, Vice Mayor Bagley, and Councilmembers Aguirre, Chapman, Elnoubi, Greene, and McPike: I am writing to express my strong interest in serving as a citizen member of the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority (ARHA). As someone with over a decade of renting experience and skills in stakeholder management and community organizing, I am a strong candidate to fill one of the commission's three vacancies. While I have always been a strong advocate for affordable and moderately priced housing — and believe in ARGAs mission of being an innovator in mixed-income communities and resident self-sufficiency — my interest in ARHA stems from a more tangible desire to see the commission better-run and more community-minded. The recent scandal of the former CEO certainly made ARHA top of mind for many Alexandria residents — but this was not the case for me. My engagement with ARHA, or more precisely, with ARHA communities and residents, stems from a dispute between The Ladrey, a senior living community owned and managed by the commission, and The Annie B. Rose House, an adjacent senior living community built on a lot owned by ARHA. I saw firsthand the importance of community engagement, how rudimentary bureaucratic decisions can affect the lives and livelihoods of vulnerable people, and why trust in ARHA is so valuable — and how a lack of trust can create headaches and unnecessary expense for the City. You, the members of the City Council, have a tremendous opportunity to constitute a commission with board members who do more than check boxes, but who actively ask questions, encourage growth and better customer service, and otherwise look out for the interests of the residents who call ARHA properties home. A well managed and run ARHA is a win for residents and the City alike. There have been several attempts to reform ARHA since the 80's, and the need for continued reform efforts is clear. I would like to be a part of the solution by helping to create an ARHA that sets the standard for public housing development and management by ensuring the commission. While I understand there are limits to the commission's role and authority and respect that ARHA professional staff and legal counsel play crucial roles in how ARHA is run. My hope is that by working together in good faith, and by being a public-facing body that encourages transparency and accountability, we will be able to move ARHA and residents forward. I therefore humbly submit this application for your consideration.
