Before moving to Alexandria in 2020, I was the Vice-Chair of (and served five years on) the Cable Advisory Committee (CAC) for the Town of Acton, Massachusetts (where I lived for 28 years). The duties/charter of the CAC overlaps with those of the Alexandria IT Commission, and the charter of the Acton CAC overlaps with that of the Commission on IT. Giving back to the community is important to me. When my kids were young enough to be in the public school system, I volunteered to be on the Technology Committee. Later on, I was a BSA volunteer (Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts), and served as Scoutmaster for four years (following three years as Assistant Scoutmaster, and was an Eagle Mentor until I moved to Alexandria). I currently volunteer teach a class at Computer CORE and just completed my training for the Alexandria Medical Reserve Corp. I have no COI; my current employer is a not-for-profit working in the public interest.
