19	more and meets the definition of "derelict building" under Va. Code § 15.2-907.1 (1950 as		
20	amended) must register the building with the director of the department of code administration		
21	provided that a building shall be deemed "continuously vacant," as that term is used in this		
22	subsection, even if it is sporadically or intermittently occupied during the 12-month period.		
23	(b) "Director" shall mean the, director of the department of code administration or the		
24	director's designee.		
25	(c) To register a building, the owner, or the owner's agent for the building, shall provide the		
26	following information to the director:		
27	(1) the address of the vacant building;		
28	(2) the name, address and telephone number of the owner and the owner's agent;		
29	(3) the name, address and telephone number of a person(s) to contact in case of an		
30	emergency, if different from the owner or the owner's agent;		
31	$(\underline{43})$ a detailed statement which estimates how long the building is likely to remain vacant <del>and</del>		
32	the reasons for it remaining vacant during that period;		
33	(5) proof that the owner or agent has implemented an on-going rodent abatement and		
34	prevention plan for the interior and exterior of the building and		

- the property is maintained in compliance with all applicable building and health codes;

  (6) if the building is located in a historic district established by article X of the zoning ordinance of the City of Alexandria, or in any conservation or rehabilitation district established.

- (d) The building owner shall pay an annual registration fee of \$25100. The fee shall be paid at the time that the building is initially registered. For each subsequent year, or any part of such year, that the building remains continuously vacant, an annual and non-refundable fee of \$25100 shall be paid within 15 days of the anniversary date of the building's initial registration.

14	imposed pursuant to this section if the owner fails to renew the registration within 15 days of the		
15	anniversary of the building's initial registration.		
16	(c) Notice of the imposition of a civil penalty pursuant to this section shall be mailed to the		
17	owner, at the address to which property tax notices are sent, at least 30 days prior to the		
18 19	imposition of the penalty. The notice and any subsequent enforcement action shall comply with the provisions of city code section 1-1-11.
