

Summary

Request

Encroachment for the construction of a wall in the right-of-way

Background Information

View along King Street

Existing Condition


- ► Wall encroaches into public right-ofway, 4.7' from the property line
- Existing sidewalk is 4.4' wide

Prior Application

- Grading plan previously approved
- Did not include changes to wall

Revised Application


 Request to demolish and rebuild wall in current location







Requested Encroachment







Staff Analysis

- Requested encroachment does not meet City criteria
 - ► Limits the intended function of the right-of-way
 - ► The encroachment is not required to remedy a construction or historical error
 - Privatizes the right-of-way in this location
- Staff recommends an alternative, limited encroachment
 - Cost and site impacts limited
 - Allows for work necessary to connect to neighboring wall, which would remain in place
 - Provides immediate public benefit of passing space along otherwise narrow sidewalk

- Disapproval of Applicant Request
- Approval of Modified Encroachment
