Even before my husband and I moved to Old Town Alexandria eight years ago from Washington DC, I was an admirer of the streetscape and architecture of Old Town, Alexandria. Living here I now realize that Old Town is not a static "pretty picture" but a dynamic juxtaposition between the preservation of its essential historic fabric and pressures from those less interested or aware of the value of its historic elements. My belief in historic preservation and correct restoration techniques was put to the test managing our three-year project involving our 1852 firehouse home. Not surprisingly, we found that it was far from intuitive, inexpensive or quick to "do it right" even though we were extremely motivated and determined to do the project correctly. How then can the HRPC encourage others who may be less aware or motivated to preserve and protect our historic assets? My interest in participating in the HRPC is to apply what I learned from my experience to encourage preservation and historically correct methods of restoration. In particular, I am interested in how exterior and interior easements can be used to preserve assets beyond the life of current owners. Hopefully, in addition to my recent design and management experience, my skills as a researcher and analyst would be useful to the HRPC in exploring solutions to these important questions.
