Alvah T. Beander, FRICS, FRSA, MBA, is a personal property valuer/appraiser specializing in African, African American, and African Diaspora art. In 2021, she was the first African American woman awarded the designation of Fellow in the Royal Institutes of Chartered Surveyors; Fine Arts & Antiques (RICS). Recently, she was appointed to The Valuation Professional Group Panel as the only Arts & Antiques representative. In January 2023, she was awarded the designation of a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts, Manufactures, and Commerce (RSA). She is a frequent lecturer and has presented globally. She was the first African American to appraise for a sitting president. She appraised the African art gifts to former President George W. Bush and Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice. She was a consultant to the National Museum of African American History and Culture Plan for Action Presidential Commission. She is an Adjunct Professor of Business and has developed a curriculum for an Entrepreneurship certification program. Alvah is the former Chair of the Board of Directors of the Fairfax County Public Library Foundation. She has served on the University President's Alumni and Art Advisory Board. Bennett College awarded her the Alumnae Achievement Award and the President's Award.
