

Permanent Pedestrianization 200 Block of King Street





Request: Permanent pedestrianization of the 200 block of King Street

Council Action:

 Approve the permanent closure of the 200 block of King Street to vehicular traffic

Key Elements of the Proposal:

- Two-phase pilot well received and permanent pedestrianization supported by the public as well as the majority of businesses on the block
- Pedestrianization did not precipitate parking- and traffic-related issues





- Unit and 100 Blocks of King Street permanently closed
- Staff evaluation of 200 Block closure deemed desirable
 - T&ES, APD, AFD, & Visit Alexandria
- Ordinance approves permanent closure of the 200 block of King Street beginning October 1, 2025

Pilot Program Dates

Closed - November 22, 2024 - January 3, 2025

Reopened – January 3, 2025 – March 14, 2025

Closed - March 14, 2025 - September 30, 2025










