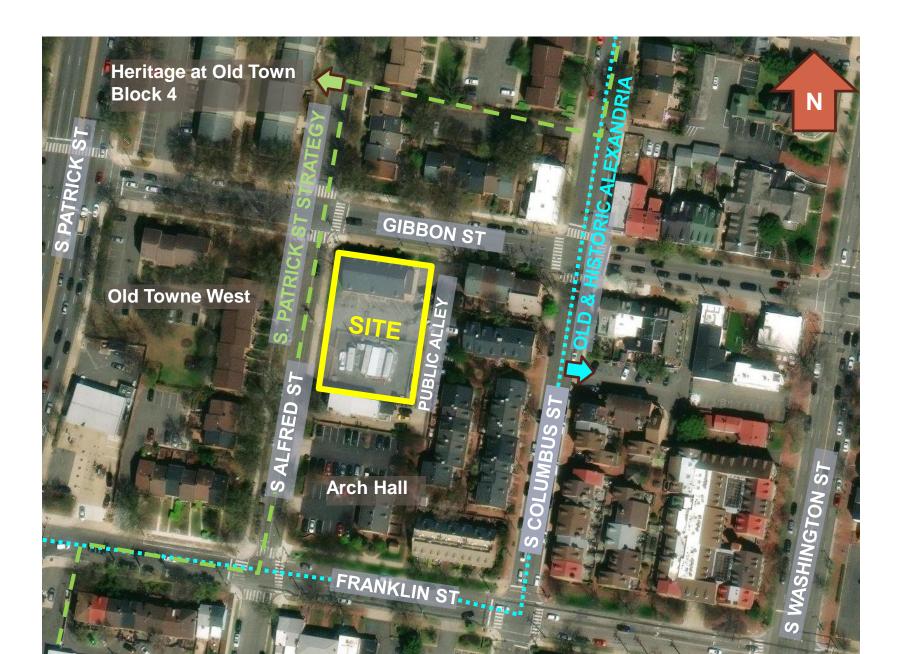

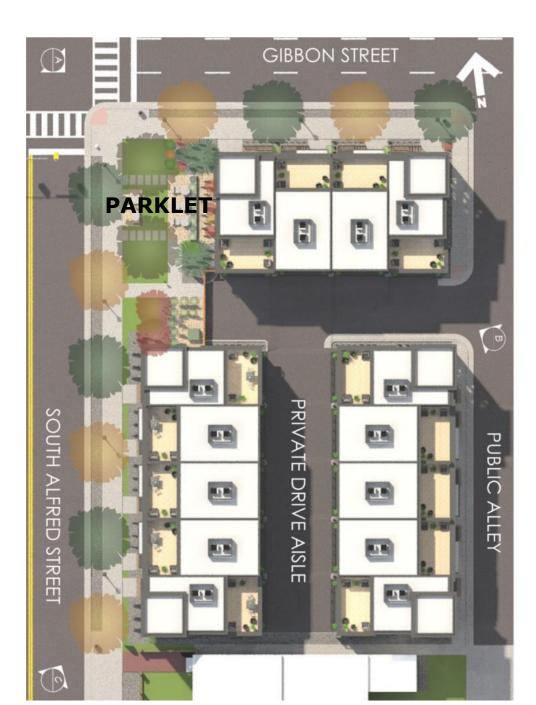

- Rear-loaded garage parking accessed via public alley off Gibbon Street
- Open space includes publicly accessible corner parklet and rooftop terraces
- Streetscape improvements including 10 new street trees, landscape buffer and widened sidewalks
