**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATION FOR METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TRANSPORTATION-LAND USE CONNECTIONS PROGRAM FOR FY 2026**

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation-Land Use Connections (TLC) Program is administered by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG); and

**WHEREAS**, the TLC Program is intended to fund short-term consultant services to local jurisdictions for small planning projects that promote mixed-use, walkable communities and support a variety of transportation alternatives; and

**WHEREAS**, the TLC Program provides up to \$80,000 in technical assistance for planning projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alexandria City Council adopted the Alexandria Mobility Plan in 2021, which aims to improve mobility, access, safety, and convenience for all users; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alexandria City Council adopted the AlexWest Small Area Plan in 2024, which calls for a future multi-modal transportation network; and

**WHEREAS**, North Beauregard Street is one of the corridors on the City’s High Crash Corridor Network based on crash data analysis in the Vision Zero Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alexandria City Council desires to submit an application to the TLC Program for up to \$80,000 for Fiscal Year 2026 for the Beauregard Trail Feasibility Study; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby supports the application for up to \$80,000 from the TLC Program from MWCOG for Fiscal Year 2026.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Alexandria City Council hereby grants authority to the City Manager to apply for this grant and enter into any necessary agreements with the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments to accept this grant.
