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WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) administers the Virginia Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF), whereby localities receive grant funding to reduce the impacts of flooding, including flooding driven by Climate Change;

WHEREAS, DCR is organizing a sixth round of CFPF grant applications;

WHEREAS, an estimated \$3,600,000 is needed for the Valley Drive Storm Drain Improvements capital project;

WHEREAS, an estimated \$2,346,000 is needed for the Phase 2 Four Mile Run and Hooffs Run Inlet Replacement project;

WHERES, the City Council of the City of Alexandria desires to apply for an allocation of matching grant funds during Round 6 of the CFPF application process for \$1,800,000, which is 50% of the estimated \$3,600,000 for the Valley Drive Storm Drain Improvements capital project;

WHERES, the City Council of the City of Alexandria desires to apply for an allocation of matching grant funds during Round 6 of the CFPF application process for \$1,173,000, which is 50% of the estimated \$2,346,000 for the Phase 2 Four Mile Run and Hooffs Run Inlet Replacement project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria hereby supports this application for an allocation of \$2,973,000 through the DCR CFPF grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

- 1. The City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby endorses this application for an allocation up to \$2,973,000 through the Round 6 Virginia CFPF grant program to fund the Valley Drive Storm Drain Improvements capital project and the Phase 2 Four Mile Run and Hooffs Run Inlet Replacement project.
- 2. The City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby grants authority for the City Manager to accept these funds, if awarded, and to execute project administration agreements related to acceptance of these funds.
- 3. The City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby commits to fund the local share for the implementation of these capital projects in accordance with the cost estimate.
