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18 The proposed ordinance amends the current Independent Community Policing Review
19 Board and Independent Policing Auditor/Investigator ordinance. It allows the Board to
20 retain authority to review investigations conducted by Alexandria Police Department;
21 provides the Auditor's primary role would be monitoring while still maintaining authority
22 to investigate complaints; establish a formal inquiry intake process; request investigations
23 pursuant to identified patterns and practices of potential discrimination, bias and unequal
24 treatment; amend Board training, quorum and meeting requirements and duties; and a
25 new provision outlining the process of removal of Board members.
